Minutes of an EXTRA PARISH COUNCIL MEETING held Monday 14<sup>th</sup> December 2020 at 5.15pm via Zoom Video Conferencing

1. To receive Apologies

**Noted:** Apologies were received from Cllrs Jewitt (business) and Martin (personal)

### 2. Disclosure of interest in items on the agenda

To receive from members, disclosure of any (a) Disclosable Pecuniary Interests and, (b) Other Disclosable Interests as required under Chapter 7 of the Localism Act 2011 and Kingsmead Parish Council's Code of Conduct.

Noted: Cllr Williams declared a non-pecuniary interest in the planning application (Item 7), remained in

the meeting but took no part in the discussion or decision.

### 4. Land at St George's Way

To consider the correspondence received (emailed prior to the meeting) and agree the appropriate response.

It was moved that this item be considered in closed session as the information to be disclosed related to a legal matter. A vote was put and a unanimous decision to move to closed session was made.

Nigel Day of CHL Solicitors, appointed to provide legal advice on the matter, outlined several options open to the council following recent correspondence from the other party. Mr Day left the meeting at 6.35pm.

Councillors discussed the options and requested a costing for further legal advice to be considered at the next meeting of the council.

Cllr Reed experienced connection problems during this agenda item and was not present during the entirety. Cllr Hoey joined the meeting at 6.30pm.

### 7. Planning

To discuss the parish council's response to the following application:

## 20/04154/FUL 4 Eyston Close Northwich Cheshire CW9 8UP

Erection of Single storey rear extension and removal and relocation of boundary fencing.

Cllr Williams took no part in the discussion or decision.

Councillors discussed the application and decided that a response would be entered on the Cheshire West and Chester planning portal raising concerns, not with the extension itself, but with the impact that the movement of the boundary might have on the overall street scene; the environmental implications of removing mature shrubbery to be replaced with similar planting much closer to the pathway; the potential loss of green open space and the encroachment of the boundary on to the service strip.
