

### **MINUTES**

Minutes of a meeting of the Parks Committee of Kingsmead Parish Council held on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2023

### 192 Apologies

#### 193 Declarations of Interest

Cllr Van Gordon declared a non-pecuniary interest for agenda items relating to play equipment.

#### 194 Public Forum

There were no members of public present.

# 195 | Minutes

The minutes of a Parks Committee meeting held on Monday 21st November 2022 were circulated prior to the meeting and assumed to be read. It was requested that an amendment should be made to agenda item 110.2, to formally record that the committee agreed that play areas would not be edged off prior to the bark topping up. It was resolved to accept the minutes as a correct record once this amendment has been made.

### 196 Budget

**To confirm** the budget and expenditure on park equipment for the last three to five years (requested at the last committee meeting).

It was noted that a total of £82k had been invested in the play parks over the last 5-years, with a significant investment being made in new play equipment in 2019/20 and 2021/22. A budget of £39k has been set for the next financial year.

# 197 | Kensington Way Park

197.1. **To receive** an update regarding advice and quotes to improve the drainage problem at Kensington Way park. **To approve** next actions.

Three quotes had been received regarding the drainage problem, but the committee agreed to carry out further investigations before a decision was made about the best course of action. Caddis would be asked to investigate the pipe under Kensington Way to see if this could facilitate a better drainage system.

197.2. **To receive** an update regarding a project to refurbish the slide equipment.

There was a discussion about the lifespan of the slide, and it was agreed to review this when the latest play inspection reports were received. **It was agreed** that the cost of removing the concrete would be investigated instead of looking to replace the whole installation.

# 198 Kingslawn Close

198.1. **To consider and approve** alternative proposals for the installation of new equipment at Kingslawn Close. **To approve** next actions.

The committee considered quotes from three play companies, and **it was resolved to approve** a quote from Play & Leisure to install a Velocity Basket Swing at a cost of £16.5k. This would include the installation of equipment and a refurbishment of the play area (removal of the small barked area and improvements to the large play area).

198.2. **To consider and approve** a plan for the refurbishment of the bark area.

Three quotes had been received for the stand-alone refurbishment of the bark area at Kingslawn Close. However, it was resolved that this work would not be carried out, but that the refurbishment would be done as a complete project with the installation of new equipment.

### 199 | Monarch Drive Play Area

To consider and approve actions to be taken regarding an ash tree and its roots at Monarch Drive play area.

It has been confirmed by Caddis that the tree in question is an ash tree, and it was resolved to approve it being felled as part of the Parish Council's ash dieback project. It was further approved that the roots should be removed from the play area by Countrywide at a cost of £95 plus VAT.

## 200 Actions from Previous Meetings

To confirm completed and outstanding actions from previous meetings

- Recommendations regarding the gym trail reports.
  It was noted in the report from Pentagon Play that no remedial actions were required.
- Topping up of play area bark.
  It was confirmed that Northwich Town Council would top up the bark in all the play areas (except Kingslawn Close) at a cost of £7500. Kingslawn Close would be refurbished as part of the new equipment installation project.
- Minor remedial works identified in play inspection reports.
  The minor remedial works are to be undertaken by Northwich Town Council.
- Play area signs.

The play area signs are to be put up by Cllr Jewitt. It was confirmed that an additional sign has been ordered for Capesthorne Close and that 2x additional signs are to be installed at Kensington Way.

# 201 Strategy

To consider and approve a 3 to 5-year plan for the management and refurbishment of the Kingsmead play parks.

It was agreed that a holistic approach should be considered as part of the council's strategy, taking into account its ambitions to improve the park areas and to ensure sustainability. The committee agreed that a walk-round would be helpful to consider all relevant issues.
