SUSPICIOUS MALE

Over the course of the past couple of Months , there have been reports within the community , knocking on residents doors and trying to sell items. When the residents have not stated that they are not interested , the Male has hurled abuse at the resident.

In the past patrols have been dispatched and there has been SEARCH MADE NO TRACE.

On the 18th JULY there was another report of another MALE within the DAVENHAM area , heading towards the MOULTON area. POSO LEE was dispatched , who gained more details from the reporting person (description , timings , etc)

The MALE was located at the top of JACK LANE and spoken to. His details were obtained and checked and was advised to not return to the area due to reports that were coming in. This male did not meet the description of the male described in previous reports.

The Male got picked up and details of that person was obtained to and again this person was spoken to and advised not to return to the location.

As they have been advised not to return to the area by PCSO LEE and this advice is not taken , we ask residents to continue reporting if seen again , and then further action can be taken

ASB (Anti- Social Behaviour)

Anti-social behaviour (ASB) is **conduct that has caused – or is likely to cause – harassment, alarm or distress to any person.** The resources in this toolkit can support police officers to tackle ASB.

Within JULY , your community team , teamed up with WEAVER VALE and conducted a ASB event in LEFTWICH , in which any residents that attended were told about their rights to report any issues that relate to ASB

Over the past couple of months there have been issues within the whole of the community that have been dealt with by PC LOCK , PCSO LEE. From youths on BUTCHERS STILE / LABURNUM PARK causing a disturbance, youths shouting abuse at parents and school teacher in KINGSMEAD , youths throwing items around a park area in KINGSMEAD to youths being rowdy in a park in LEFTWICH. These issues were reported to 101 and together with residents , schools and CCTV, the people involved were identified and therefore action has been taken against them. Therefore we do ask , if there are any issues please report them to 101

WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of 4 or 5 adults arguing around the ROWING CLUB AREA— RESPONSE PCS dispatched , Search Made No Trace , spoke to REPORTING PERSON and they stated that the group had moved on
- Report of threatening messages being received on FACEBOOK— Safeguarding Advice given. PCSO to call round for Reassurance
- Report of two males fighting outside REPORTING PERSONS address—RESPONSE PCS attended—search made no trace of the males
- Report of threatening messages being received— SAFEGUARDING advice given—PCSO to call for a reassurance visit

LEFTWICH

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of youths riding up and down CLIFTON DRIVE on OFFROAD BIKES—RESPONSE PCS dispatched Search Made No Trace
- Report of TWO FEMALES seen climbing over REPORTING PERSONS fence and walk through the garden—PCSO completed REASSURANCE VISIT gained information concerning this and will be in contact with PARTNER AGENCIES in regard to this which REPORTING PERSON is happy with
- Report of a large group of youths around the shop area on CLIFTON DRIVE late at night causing a disturbance , possible drug related—RESPONSE PCS dispatched youths had left the area. REPORTING PERSON has given details of some of the youths involved. Patrols by COMMUNITY POLICE to continue.
- Report of a suspicious car in area , stopping by REPORTING PERSONS location and looking at their property.—PC / PCSO completed a REASSURANCE VISIT and gained information of the vehicle. No sightings since
- Report of a possible Break in at the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING—Information passed to COMMUNITY POLICE and patrols to continue , which led to a patrol occurring and YOUTHS spotted trying to get into the building. Details obtained and parents spoken to.
- Report of a LARGE BANG in area , which happened the same time as youths walked past—PATROLS DISPATCHED no damage to property or vehicles
- Report of suspicious activity on OLD HALL ROAD , which may be DRUG RELATED - Logged as INTEL , PC / PCSO completed a REASSURANCE VISIT to gain more information. No issues since
- Report of threatening messages received on phone— RESPONSE PCS attended reassurance given—CIVAL matter between former partners
- Report of Neighbour issues which may be linked to HARRASSMENT—PC / PCSO attended addresses. Issue resolved and advice given to all parties involved, further issues will result in further action taken
- Report of a neighbour dispute which involved threats—PC / PCSO attended addresses, both parties spoken to and advice given. Further issues will result in further action taken
- Report of threatening messages received (which is linked to a report made from the WEAVER HALL location) - PCSO to call for reassurance
- Report of a disturbance within an address— RESPONSE PCS attended and MALE ARRESTED
- Report of threatening messages being received in relation to a missing cat— SAFEGUARDING advice given and PCSO called for reassurance—no answer , PCSO left details to contact
- Report of a possible stabbing—RESPONSE PCS attended , person was not stabbed and was very intoxicated.

KINGSMEAD

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of a MALE asking for money around the REGENCY WAY RETAIL AREA—PATROLS dispatched and Search Made No Trace
- Report of threatening behaviour / assault— RESPONSE PCS attended , issue between family members—no injuries and person who was making the threats spoken to
- Report of a neighbour knocking on REPORTING PERSONS door and threatening them— PCSO calling for reassurance
- Report of youths knocking and running on REPORTING PERSONS door—RESPONSE PCS attended, Search Made No Trace. PCSO to call round seek out images of the youths and identify them and have a chat with them and parents if possible.

DAVENHAM

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of a large group of youths on LONDON ROAD, next to the ODDFELLOWS causing a disturbance in the early hours— REPORTING PERSON called back stating that they had moved on POLICE not required. PCSO Called for REASSURANCE and to get further info, REPORTING PERSON not in and no contact since,
- Report of youths causing a disturbance on BUCHTERS STILE at 2300—PCSO attended and gained more information and will continue to conduct patrols . CCTV was checked.
- Report of a suspicious Male in area trying to sell items to residents. When residents don't buy or state they are not interested then the male gets angry and shouts abuse.—PCSO dispatched , MALE located and details obtained. Advised not to return to the area.
- Report of youths taking REPORTING PERSONS property from the LABURUM ROAD—PCSO attended address for reassurance , CCTV is available so the identity of the youth can be obtained, but having issues trying to send to PCSO.

MOULTON

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of threatening messages received on FACEBOOK—safeguard advice given , PC / PCSO called to complete a reassurance visit , no issues since and person blocked

FRAUD

- Report of a transaction taking place over facebook marketplace. BUYER bought the item and sent money , instantly the SELLER removed profile and blocked BUYER—PCSO to conduct reassurance / safeguarding visit.

FRAUD ADVICE

PROTECT YOURSELF ON MARKETPLACE

Facebook Marketplace is not as secure as other selling sites that are on the internet. There has been issues in the past that BUYERS send money for items and then do not receive the item, then SELLERS are being told that money is sent so that the item can be sent to BUYER, but then the money HAS NOT been sent in the first place. Sites such as EBAY have sellers / buyers protection in place in case anything goes wrong. Other sites use PAYPAL which has protection in place for BUYERS / SELLERS. But FACEBOOK MARKETPLACE has not. So please ensure that everything is legit before sending money, or sending the item.

What you can do :

- If you're the buyer, DO NOT send money via bank transfer or debit card as these do not have protection in place. If you use CREDIT CARD to pay for items and you don't receive the items then the CREDIT CARD company can chase this up and look into this for you. Or use PAYPAL to send money other so there is some protection in place for you
- If you're the SELLER—ensure money has been received. Do not take someones word that money has been sent. There has been issues where the buyer has come to collect the item and used an APP to send money other. This APP does not send the money, it just shows a screen showing that money has been sent, when it hasn't. So the SELLER has lost out. Suggest the BUYER to send money via PAYPAL so both parties are covered.
