KNIFE ISSUES

Over the past few weeks we have received a number of reports of individuals :

- Carry Knives
- Threatening people with knives , either with the knife on show or just by saying they would stab them

In all cases , these are taken seriously by NORTHWICH POLICE and in all cases that were reported RESPONSE PCS have attended , with one person being arrested and further enquires being made in relation to the other issues.

Within the community STOP / SEARCHES will be completed by the COMMUNITY TEAM if there is anyone suspicious within the area. This is to get the message out to everyone we are acting on these reports and as preventive measure.

We do ask if you see or hear anyone with a KNIFE to call 999.



CANNABIS USE

Another issue within the community is the reports of CANNABIS USE.

Did you know CANNABIS is still ILLEGAL even for personal use.

The reports we are getting is in regards to people using it for PERSONAL USE and the smell is causing the people who live in the area issues.

With all the reports we are getting the COMMUNITY TEAM do have an action plan , which has already taken place within one area.

This includes :

- Gathering intel
- Conducting patrols
- Conducting house to house / Street a week operations
- Getting in touch with our Housing Partners if necessary.

Gathering INTEL is our main important source as if we don't know about an issue we cant act. So we thank those residents who helped with the INTEL they have provided already to help with our ACTION PLAN.

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of possible CANNABIS USE in the area—PCSO to call to gain more information and place area on PATROL PLAN if further INTEL for the area calls for it
- 2x Reports of suspicious activity. HGV unloading numerous trays / cases of a popular drink—*PCSO LEE has spoken to reporting person , no further issues*
- Report of a MALE causing a disturbance at the BOWLING GREEN—*RESPONSE PCS dispatched and MALE taken back to his home*

LEFTWICH

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of YOUTHS being loud and causing a disturbance around the Wooded Area / LEFTWICH HIGH SCHOOL—PCSO to call for REASSURANCE and place on PATROL PLAN
- Report of YOUTHS being loud around the CLIFTON DRIVE SHOP AREA— PCSO knows of the issue and is already on PATROL PLAN. This issue came in at 1830.
- Report of LARGE GROUP OF YOUTHS outside the shops on CLIFTON DRIVE being loud at 2130.—RESPONSE dispatched and YOUTHS spoken to and moved on
- Report of LARGE GROUP OF YOUTHS at the BUS STOP on CLIFTON DRIVE being loud at 2115.—RESPONSE dispatched and YOUTHS spoken to and moved on
- Report of DANGEROUS DRIVING as pedestrian was using ZEBRA CROSSING on LONDON ROAD, vehicle did not stop and mounted curb—REG taken and INTEL logged in regards to this
- Report of THREATS from one neighbour to another in regards to noise from a MOTOBike—RESPONSE dispatched and both neighbours spoken to. PCSO called as well at a later date for REASSURANCE
- Ongoing NEIGHBOUR ISSUES— RESPONSE dispatched and is looking into the issue, as previous attendance by POLICE , one neighbour given a WARNING
- Report of a Vehicle left running for approx 45 mins with no one in sight—*Vehicle details checked and owner spoken to, did not realise / forgot that vehicle was left running*
- Report of a Male threatening to STAB another male—*RESPONSE dispatched and MALE ARRESTED*
- Report of a Male with a SWISS ARMY KNIFE threatening another male—*RESPONSE dispatched , witnesses spoken to. House to House enquires occurred and no CCTV or further information . Location of the Male making threats is unknown—no further reports—closed down.*
- Report of son of Reporting Person being threatened and harassed—*RESPONSE PCS dispatched and issue stems from bullying in which school has been contacted in regards to this. PCSO LEE to conduct a REASSURANCE VISIT*
- Report of large group of YOUTHS being loud and causing a disturbance by LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING—*RESPONSE PCS dispatched as soon as arrived on location youths ran off , local COMMUNITY TEAM are aware of issue with LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING*
- Report of a disturbance due to FEMALE shouting and arguing with another person and forcing her way into the property—*RESPONSE PCS dispatched and all involved spoken to and safeguarded*
- Report of a FEMALE being harassed and threatened outside of LEFTWICH HIGH SCHOOL—*Youth engagement team looking into this issue*
- *Report of a MALE being threatened by another MALE with a HOMEMADE KNIFE - REPRTING PERSON does not want to make a statement. PC LOCK and PCSO LEE has placed onto PATROL PLAN and will speak with persons involved*
- Report from a third party in regards to welfare due to issue with money— *REPOSENSE PCS attended and the victim did not police interference*
- Report of TWO DOGS fighting each other inside of property—*RESPONSE PCS dispatched and DOGS separated , superficial injuries and no complaint made*

THEFT

- Report of a BIKE being stolen from a SHED.—*PCSO to get in touch with WEAVER VALE in regards to this*
- Report of a bowl of apples being taken from outside property , apples are usually left for people to take , but bowl was taken as well—*CRIMED*

KINGSMEAD

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of a CARER being assaulted by person who they were caring for— Third party report , RESPONSE attended the CARERS address
- Report of a GROUP OF MALES being loud and shouting at each other—No other reports , was an argument between males
- Report of comments / insults being stated about the Reporting Person on social media—*Reporting person stated that he would not be available for a while to speak to. PCSO LEE will try and conduct a REASSURANCE VISIT*
- Report of a DOG BITE to a CHILD outside KINGSMEAD PRIMARY SCHOOL—*Details of the reporting person , victim and owner of dog were not left*
- Report of a SUSPICIOUS CAR driving around the CHELFORD DRIVE area—*PCSO LEE to conduct a REASSURANCE VISIT to gain further information*

THEFT

- Report of a FEMALE adding REPORTING PERSON on snap chat and REPORTING PERSON accepted and had a conversation. Within the conversation pictures were exchange. The FEMALE then demanded money to stop her spreading these images that REPORTING PERSON sent.—No money was sent—SAFEGUARDING ADVICE given to REPORTING PERSON
- Report of a WALLET possibly being STOLEN as REPORTING PERSON has not seen the wallet for 3 days—PCSO to call for REASSURANCE

DAVENHAM

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of a SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE parked opposite reporting persons address—*REG taken and checked , vehicle is causing no obstruction—PCSO to check on vehicle*
- Report of a FEMALE being locked inside of her house— *Female suffers from DIMENTIA , son and carers was contacted .*
- Report of YOUTHS being loud on BUTCHERS STILE—*RESPONSE PCS dispatched and there were no offences due to the time that report was made, as location is a public area with a closure time of 2200 and report made before this*
- Report of a FEMALE walking around and looking confused—*RESPONSE PCS dispatched and SEARCH around location and into MOULTON , NO TRACE of female*
- Report of a MALE shouting at a FEMALE for walking her dog on the footpath—*words of advice given by PSCO LEE and will conduct a REASSURANCE VISIT*
- Report of a MALE found walking around in FRONT GARDEN—*RESPONSE PCS and PCSO DONNELLY dispatched , MALE located and made comfortable and carers collected him as he was from nearby CARE HOME.*
- Report of a CHILD being bitten by a DOG , whilst walking—*PCSO LEE to conduct REASSURANCE VISIT*

THEFT

- Report of parcels being left at NEIGHBOURS ADDRESS. Person who these parcels belong to not being able to get parcels of neighbour.—*PCSO spoke to reporting person and the parcel has been found*
- Report of a possible break in due to damage to door—*RESPONSE PCS dispatched and door looked at , reporting person can not confirm if anything was taken. House to House conducted*

MOULTON

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of a CUSTOMER being aggressive and not leaving when asked to do so—REPOSE dispatched as is an ongoing issue. Customer left.
- Report of FEMALE being violent due to being BARRED from location and refused entry—RESPONSE PCS dispatched and FEMALE spoken to and moved on
- Further report to the above incident , FEMALE being assaulted by the MALE who would not allow her into the building
- Report of a dog being bought online and returned due to circumstances and refund has not occurred—*advice given as this is a CIVIL ISSUE. PCSO LEE to conduct a REASSURANCE VISIT*

- Report of a MALE Shoplifting from MORRISONS—PCSO LEE attended and gained CCTV of the MALE and the imaged sent to officers for IDENTIFICATION

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of a female walking on the A533 just wearing underwear—RESPONSE dispatched SEARCH MADE , NO TRACE

- Report of a Broken Down Vehicle in a LIVE LANE and causing major obstructions—RESPONSE DISPATCHED—SEARCH MADE NO TRACE

- YOU SAY , WE DID -

- YOU SAY - Parking is an issue especially around DUKES WAY / CASTLEMEAD WALK / REGAL CLOSE / BUCKINGHAM DRIVE when its school pick up.

- WE DID - PCSO Lee conducted a parking patrol around the roads listed above around 14:55 - 15:20. Two Drivers realised they couldn't park on DOUBLE YELLOW LINES when noticed PCSO LEE and moved on. But however 2 TICKETS were issue to two drivers on REGENCY WAY RETAIL PARK for using DISABLED PARKING BAYS and not having a BLUE BADGE.

Please not DISABLED BAYS are for DISABLED USERS who have a BLUE BADGE only.

Last night an operation took place in HARTFORD, in our ongoing effects to tackle county lines drug dealing.

3 Males were ARRESTED at HARTFORD TRAIN STATION. All 3 males are suspected of being involved in the transportation of illegal drugs from Liverpool to Northwich.

One of these three males was a 57 year old who is from the LEFTWICH AREA.

YOU SAY --- Speeding is a issue on HARTFORD ROAD

WE ACT --- Speed session has been conducted on HARTFORD ROAD , this morning from 0830 - 0900. The reason why this time was picked was due to increased traffic flow and increased Pedestrians. HARTFORD ROAD is 20 MPH , during this time 19 OFFENCES were captured with the highest speed being 43MPH

Due to this HARTFORD ROAD will become a regular place for the SPEED CAMERA



This year HARTFORD AND GREENBANK introduced the MINI POLICE , where children from HARTFORD PRIMARY applied for the role and attended the attestation they became a part of the MINI POLICE team.

The MINI POLICE joined HARTFORD AND GREENBANK POLICE on patrols around the community to tackle
- school parking

- asb patrols

and joined in on police surgeries to listen to residents issues and concerns.

And it has been a success.

- ASB Patrols around OLD HALL ROAD PARK AREA—**Patrols are occurring by the COMMUNITY TEAM when on EVENING DUTIES. Any youths in the area are being spoken to and details taken. If required this will progress to STOP/SEARCHES**
- School Parking— **Patrols have now increased to cover—ELLESMERE ROAD , BELGRAVE ROAD , OLD HALL ROAD and GRANVILLE ROAD—please see separate update**
- Patrols around the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING—**Patrols are occurring by the COMMUNITY TEAM when on EVENING DUTIES and attended by RESPONSE PCS when 101 reports come in**

- Speed Monitoring on MONARCH DRIVE—**26 Offences Captured and Processed**
- School / College Parking—**Please see separate update**

DAVEHAM

- ASB Patrols around BUTCHERS STILE / LABURNUM ROAD PLAY AREAS—**Patrols are being conducted by the COMMUNITY TEAM when on EVENING DUTIES and if there is anyone in area (approaching 22:00 in BUTCHERS STILE and after dark in LABURNUM ROAD) they are being spoken to and details taken if necessary.**
- School Parking—**PATROL now extended to include—MOUNT PLEASANT from CHARLES AVE to front of FOUNTAIN COURT—plus see separate update**
