116 Minutes

To approve and sign the minutes of a meeting held on Monday 11th September 2023.

Resolved – that the minutes of the meeting were a correct record and should be signed by the Chair.

117 | Maintenance and Landscaping

- 117.1. To receive the following updates from Countrywide Grounds Maintenance and to approve any actions.
 - a) Monthly report
 - b) Schedule for October
 - c) Hedge cutting
 - d) Works to be completed

The September monthly report and schedules for October maintenance and hedge cutting were noted. It was agreed that checks would be made $w/c 9^{th}$ October on the grass cutting and the hedges. The outstanding jobs listed were to be followed up.

117.2. To appoint a working group to review the grounds maintenance contract and tender document.

<u>Resolved</u> – that Cllrs Hoey, Jewitt (tbc), Swift and Van Gordon (tbc) form a working group to start reviewing the grounds maintenance contract and tender document.

117.3. **To receive** feedback regarding the siting of a bench near to the sluice pond and **to approve** a quote for securing the bench.

<u>Resolved</u> – that the bench be sited at the sluice pond, away from the railings, and further to the right-hand side, and that a councillor (Cllr Hoey or Reed) be in attendance on the day of installation to confirm the final position.

<u>Resolved</u> – that the bench should be secured with its own Earth Anchors in the grass and not on a concrete base.

117.4. To receive an update regarding ash dieback works and to approve any actions.

<u>Resolved</u> – that it should be considered at the budget review whether additional funds need to be allocated for ongoing work in the next financial year.

117.5. **To retrospectively approve** a quote from Caddis for the removal of a tree behind the fire station (approved by the Chair and Clerk according to Financial Regulations).

<u>Resolved</u> – to retrospectively approve the work done by Caddis under the authorisation of the Chair and Clerk.

117.6. To consider and approve advice and quotes from Caddis for the following tree works:

- a) 17 Sandringham Close
- b) 3 Earl's Way
- c) 32 Mayfair Drive
- d) Woodland adjacent to Capesthorne Close
- e) Hedging and trees on the cenotaph side of the spine road between the Kingfisher roundabout and London Road.

<u>Resolved</u> – to defer a decision on all quotes to the next meeting.

117.7. **To approve** the purchase of wildflower seeds and **to agree** when soil preparation and sowing should be carried out.

<u>Resolved</u> – to approve the purchase of Cheshire Native Mix (from Boston Seeds) for re-sowing the wildflower area and to obtain a quote for harrowing in the spring.

117.8. **To approve** a date for the removal of plants from the cenotaph beds and for the area to be returned to grass only.

Resolved – that the plants be removed ASAP from the cenotaph and the beds returned to grass.

117.9. **To receive** any other updates.

It was discussed that the strategy working group should consider removing the sluice pond bridge and jetty once their condition becomes non-viable.

Resolved – that quotes be obtained for a new soak away and replacement play surface at Kensington Way.
