## THE MINI POLICE ARE COMING

The MINI POLICE is an innovative police engagement program aimed at 8 to 11 year olds. The Mini police is a growing part of the Cheshire Police family and so far in Northwich South we have one program up and running in HARTFORD, with another one recently being started in RUDHEATH.

Davenham and Moulton Police, alongside Crimebeat, Kingsmead Parish Council and Kingsmead Primary are pleased to announce that the Mini Police are coming to KINGSMEAD.



PCSO LEE along with PCSO Richardson (Witton and Rudheath) attended Kingsmead Primary and spoke to Year 5 children about what the MINI POLICE involves. After the presentation applications were given out to those who wanted to apply.

The children had 2 weeks to complete their application and once they were received they were looked over by PCSO LEE and PC LOCK. And those who were successful were invited to an interview.



On the 1st November the interviews were held at KINGSMEAD PRIMARY with the children attending a 3 to 1 interview. The children who attended the interview were confident and gave excellent answers, even the teachers stated that they wouldn't of been that confident going into a 3 on 1 interview. The children gained

some life skills after completing the application and interview process.

All children who attended the interview were notified that had been successful in joining the MINI POLICE.

## MINI POLICE— GOING FORWARD

There will be a UNIFORM fitting on the 6th November and then a ATTESTATION (award night) on the 22nd November The Mini Police program will then officially start in the new year. Working alongside PC LOCK and PCSO LEE the mini police will attend patrols, tackle speeding and parking issues and work with the community. And as many of them said in their interview "MAKE KINGSMEAD A BETTER PLACE"

- Report of eggs being thrown at a building which is targeted— PCSO called for reassurance and possible CCTV enquires to see if there are any suspects
- Report of 3 youths all in black playing what looks like chicken across , on bikes and segway – PCSO called for reassurance but no answer , calling card left but not been in touch.
- Report of youths kicking door in and leaving a large footprint on door – PCSO to call for reassurance
- 2 x Reports of concerns in regards to CCTV being used by neighbours– ongoing neighbour issue which has been dealt with by community team. Reporting person has been advised on how to deal with CCTV concerns

## KINGSMEAD

### ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of a suspicious vehicle that drove into SIR JOHNS DEANS car park and drove around. PCSO called for reassurance and to gain further information. No further issues
- Group of youths throwing items at home and shouting abuse. Whilst on call , youths left. – PCSO called for reassurance and there have been no further issues
- Report of a resident shouting abuse at a pregnant driver and then blocking the road in regards to parking dispute– PCSO called for reassurance
- Further report in regards to abuse shouted at another neighbour in regards to parking issues —PCSO called round provided safeguarding advice to all involved and all advised if any further issues it will be taken further as there are no issues with parking
- Report of a Suspicious white van transferring packages and hanging around - PCSO to call for reassurance
- Report of a person getting attacked – RESPONSE dispatched and youths spoken to , all play fighting with each other
- Report of verbal abuse / threats towards neighbours in regards to parking dispute. – RESPONSE dispatched but neither party want to make a complaint

- Theft of push bike – CRIMED – PCSO to call for reassurance

## DAVENHAM

### ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of group of youths walking down LONDON ROAD , with a LASER PEN. PCSO Lee to call for reassurance but no answer and calling card left, but no return call
- Report of a possible issue where number plates could have been forged due to a high court letter being sent to them – PCSO spoke to reporting person and provided safeguarding advice and advised it's a civil issue.

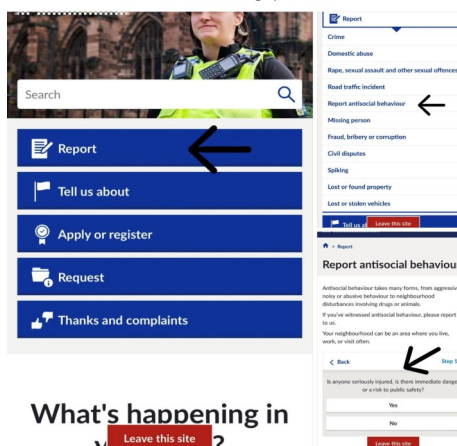
LEE also has access to BUTCHERS STILE CCTV, so if there are any issues with CCTV , then please report them to 101

# RESIDENTS VOICE UPDATE— YOU SAY , WE ACT—OCTOBER UPDATES

## LEFTWICH

- More Visibility around the WOODPECKER DRIVE AND GRANVILLE ROAD areas —Patrols are occurring by the **COMMUNITY TEAM** when on **EVENING DUTIES**. PSCO LEE also conducts school parking patrols which includes GRANVILLE ROAD.
- ASB Patrols around OLD HALL ROAD PARK AREA—Patrols are being conducted and 4 groups of youths have been in the area after dark and spoken too. Advised why they are being spoken to and details were obtained. All youths advised these patrols are occurring to prevent ASB issues
- School Parking— Patrols have now increased to cover—ELLESMERE ROAD , BELGRAVE ROAD , OLD HALL ROAD and GRANVILLE ROAD—plus after HALF TERM it will extend to WOODSIDE TERRACE
- Patrols around the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING—Patrols are occurring by the **COMMUNITY TEAM** when on **EVENING DUTIES** and attended by **RESPONSE PCS** when 101 reports come in

- RESIDENTS SAY -  
Speeding is a constant issue on MONARCH DRIVE (20MPH) especially when its college / school pick up.

- WE ACT -  
PCSO LEE conducted a SPEED CAMERA session on MONARCH DRIVE yesterday (16/10/23) from 15:30 - 16:15. There were a total of 3 offences with the highest speed of 34 MPH , which involved drivers driving past SANDBACH DRIVE and past the college.

These offences will be processed and sent to the central ticket office.

More speed camera sessions will be completed on MONARCH DRIVE due to the fact that this is a constant issue

## KINGSMEAD

- Speed Sessions on MONARCH DRIVE—**3 Offences Captured and Processed**
- Extend the School Patrol to REGENCY WAY —School Patrols now include **CASTLEMEAD WALK, REGAL CLOSE** and now **REGENCY WAY**



## DAVEHAM

- ASB Patrols around BUTCHERS STILE / LABURNUM ROAD PLAY AREAS—Patrols are being conducted by the **COMMUNITY TEAM** when on **EVENING DUTIES** and if there is anyone in area (BUTCHERS STILE, LABURNUM ROAD after dark ) they are being spoken to and details taken if necessary.
- School Parking—**PATROL** now extended to include—**MOUNT PLEASANT** from **CHARLES AVE** to front of **FOUNTAIN COURT**—plus see separate update
- Speed Sessions on MOUNT PLEASANT / FOUNTAIN LANE—**No Offences**

- Hartford Road Parking—Patrols are occurring and **2 issues of cars blocking the footpath**. Residents spoken to in regards to this, that we understand that driveways are too small for some vehicles, that they overhang , but when another vehicle is placed next to the over hang, then this is classed as an obstruction. And further issues can result in a **FIXED PENALTY NOTICE ISSUED**

## MOULTON

- Speeding on MAIN ROAD. Camera now placed further down MAIN ROAD nearer the park area—**15 offences captured and more sessions will be planned in the future**

- More Visibility around the YARDLEY AVE /

RAVENSCROFT area—Patrols have been conducted around the area. **No issues**

-- RESIDENTS SAY -- The Speed Camera Sessions that you complete on MAIN ROAD are on the wrong section.

-- WE ACT -- Yesterday PCSO LEE conducted a SPEED CAMERA session from 14:55 to 15:25 on MAIN ROAD and was concentrating on the area where drivers enter from JACK LANE and down to the PARK.

The Speed Limit on MAIN ROAD is 20MPH and there was a total of 15 offences , with the highest speed being 35MPH. These offences are being processed.

Due to high amount of offences captured , more camera sessions will be taking place

# STAY SAFE WITHIN THE COMMUNITY

## DELIVERIES

Around the community whilst on Patrols we have noticed many parcels being left by couriers on DOOR STEPS.

With the days getting darker earlier now, as we move into the AUTUMN and WINTER seasons, please protect your delivered valuables by :

- **HAVING A SAFE PLACE**—ensure that you have safe place for your deliveries to be placed , so they are not **VISIBLE** and in clear sight. Some safe places can be :
  - OVER THE FENCE
  - IN A FRONT PORCH
  - IN A BOX / BIN
- **CCTV**—If possible have a doorbell CCTV (such as RING DOOR BELL) so that your delivery is recorded onCCTV
- **DON'T LEAVE SIGNS**—Don't advertise to strangers where parcels could be placed
- **COMMUNICATE**—companies such as AMAZON and many others have notes that you can place with orders. State that they cannot leave parcels in clear sight and tell them where a safe place is so that they can leave the parcel.
