When people use Cannabis there is a pungent smell which can cause other people issues. And this can be classed as ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR as well as DRUG POSSESSION AND USE.



We do have a plan in place for all reports of Cannabis use that we are receiving. This includes notifying Housing agencies that we work with and conducting House to House operations. And if there is a breach of tenancy in relation to this , then this will be dealt with housing.

In the past there has been successful operations—

- Plain clothed operations
- House to house operations with WEAVER VALE HOUSING
- Complete support for those who are reporting by updating them with updates and gaining more information about the issue.

- Report of a young male being assaulted by two other males - RESPONSE dispatched and a COMMUNITY RESOLUTION has been ordered against the two males. PCSO LEE to call round for reassurance .
- Report in regards to noise—PCSO LEE has provided safeguarding advice and advice how to pursue this
- Report of Anti Social Behaviour around the shop area of CLIFTON DRIVE—Patrols are taken place and any youths that are in area at certain times are being questioned
- Report of a hate crime incident that took place at SCHOOL—PCSO LEE to call for reassurance and further information
- Report of Neighbour issues with CCTV— Neighbour dispute and as been advised on how to pursue this issue
- 2x Reports in regards to Offroad bikes on CLIFTON DRIVE—Patrols are occurring , need to have REG or names involved to pursue this as when marked vehicles in area , issue does not occur

- Report of a parked car being , at SCHOOL PICK UP TIMES an car did not stop. Registration was taken and passed with report— Passed to CRIME DEPARTMENT to look into.

- Report of debit card being taken from property by a neighbour—PCSO Lee attended for reassurance and safeguarding advice—Ongoing Neighbour issue

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of possible intruders at SIR JOHN DEANES COLLEGE—RESPONSE dispatched, Search Made no Trace
- Report of a House alarm being activated and possible intruder—RESPONSE dispatched and house checked, no one around , PCSO LEE to call for reassurance
- Concern for welfare as reporting person could not get in touch with father—RESPONSE dispatched , no answer at door , Forced entry. Male found collapsed as had fallen out of bed. Ambulance called
- Report of males fighting outside the KINGFISHER , unknown reason for the fight. Fight stopped and males went on their separate way , whilst caller was on the phone—RESPONSE not dispatched as fight stopped.
- Report of violence when reporting person was collecting child up from an address—RESPONSE dispatched and reporting person did not want to make a complaint
- Report of a suspicious male hanging around the address—PCSO Lee to call for reassurance.
- Report of a male entering a property from a rear door and
- Report of a male shouting verbal attacking in relation to the way they are driving—PCSO LEE to call for reassurance

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Report of a Neighbour blocking the road due to double parking—Ongoing neighbour issues. All residents within area have been advised by PCSO LEE of the issues and that if a 2nd vehicle parks next to a another vehicle and blocks the road , then the 2nd vehicle will get a ticket or possibly removed

THIS MONTHS PARISH COUNCIL MEETING
ATTENDED BY PCSO LEE

RESIDENTS VOICE UPDATE— YOU SAY , WE ACT—NOVEMBER UPDATES

LEFTWICH

- More Visibility around the WOODPECKER DRIVE AND GRANVILLE ROAD areas —Patrols are occurring by the **COMMUNITY TEAM** when on **EVENING DUTIES**. PSCO LEE also conducts school parking patrols which includes **GRANVILLE ROAD**.
- ASB Patrols around OLD HALL ROAD PARK AREA—Patrols are being conducted and 4 groups of youths have been in the area after dark and spoken too. Advised why they are being spoken to and details were obtained. All youths advised these patrols are occurring to prevent ASB issues
- School Parking— Patrols have now increased to cover—**ELLESMERE ROAD , BELGRAVE ROAD , OLD HALL ROAD and GRANVILLE ROAD**—plus after **HALF TERM** it will extend to **WOODSIDE TERRACE**
- Patrols around the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING—Patrols are occurring by the **COMMUNITY TEAM** when on **EVENING DUTIES** and attended by **RESPONSE PCS** when 101 reports come in

- RESIDENTS SAY -
Speeding is a constant issue on MONARCH DRIVE (20MPH) especially when its college / school pick up.

- WE ACT -
PCSO LEE conducted a SPEED CAMERA session on MONARCH DRIVE yesterday (16/10/23) from 15:30 - 16:15. There were a total of 3 offences with the highest speed of 34 MPH , which involved drivers driving past SANDBACH DRIVE and past the college.

These offences will be processed and sent to the central ticket office.

More speed camera sessions will be completed on MONARCH DRIVE due to the fact that this is a constant issue

KINGSMEAD

- Speed Sessions on MONARCH DRIVE—**3 Offences Captured and Processed**
- Extend the School Patrol to REGENCY WAY —School Patrols now include **CASTLEMEAD WALK, REGAL CLOSE and now REGENCY WAY**



DAVEHAM

- ASB Patrols around BUTCHERS STILE / LABURNUM ROAD PLAY AREAS—Patrols are being conducted by the **COMMUNITY TEAM** when on **EVENING DUTIES** and if there is anyone in area (BUTCHERS STILE,LABURNUM ROAD after dark) they are being spoken to and details taken if necessary.
- School Parking—**PATROL** now extended to include—**MOUNT PLEASANT from CHARLES AVE to front of FOUNTAIN COURT**—plus see separate update
- Speed Sessions on MOUNT PLEASANT / FOUNTAIN LANE—**No Offences**

-- RESIDENTS SAY -- The Speed Camera Sessions that you complete on MAIN ROAD are on the wrong section.

-- WE ACT -- Yesterday PCSO LEE conducted a SPEED CAMERA session from 14:55 to 15:25 on MAIN ROAD and was concentrating on the area where drivers enter from JACK LANE and down to the PARK.

The Speed Limit on MAIN ROAD is 20MPH and there was a total of 15 offences , with the highest speed being 35MPH. These offences are being processed.

Due to high amount of offences captured , more camera sessions will be taking place



- Hartford Road Parking—Patrols are occurring and **2 issues of cars blocking the footpath**. Residents spoken to in regards to this, that we understand that driveways are too small for some vehicles, that they overhang , but when another vehicle is placed next to the over hang, then this is classed as an obstruction. And further issues can result in a **FIXED PENALTY NOTICE ISSUED**

MOULTON

- Speeding on MAIN ROAD. Camera now placed further down MAIN ROAD nearer the park area—**15 offences captured and more sessions will be planned in the future**
- More Visibility around the YARDLEY AVE /

RAVENSROFT area—Patrols have been conducted around the area. **No issues**

PATROL UPDATES— NOVEMBER

Due to HALLOWEEN and BONFIRE NIGHT all areas within the community were patrolled due to OPERATION TREACLE— These patrols were conducted by the entire NORTHWICH SOUTH COMMUNITY TEAM and covered all areas , including HARTFORD , DAVENHAM AND MOULTON , SHAKLEY , WITTON AND RUDHEATH.

- ASB due to OFFROAD BIKES on CLIFTON DRIVE—No issues , when patrols conducted

DELIVERIES

Around the community whilst on Patrols we have noticed many parcels being left by couriers on DOOR STEPS.

With the days getting darker earlier now, as we move into the AUTUMN and WINTER seasons, please protect your delivered valuables by :

- **HAVING A SAFE PLACE**—ensure that you have safe place for your deliveries to be placed , so they are not **VISIBLE** and in clear sight. Some safe places can be :
 - OVER THE FENCE
 - IN A FRONT PORCH
 - IN A BOX / BIN
- **CCTV**—If possible have a doorbell CCTV (such as RING DOOR BELL) so that your delivery is recorded onCCTV
- **DON'T LEAVE SIGNS**—Don't advertise to strangers where parcels could be placed
- **COMMUNICATE**—companies such as AMAZON and many others have notes that you can place with orders. State that they cannot leave parcels in clear sight and tell them where a safe place is so that they can leave the parcel.

COMMUNITY TEAM INFORMATION GATHERING

Have you report issues to us and then the community team (PC LOCK / PCSO LEE) has visted you ?

Did they provide you with their email ?

IF the answer is YES and the issues are still ongoing , we need this communicated to us so that we can put a patrol plan into place. Unfortunately these patrol plans can not be action on 1 report , we would need other reports so we know :

- Its an ongoing issue
- The patrol plan will be action at the correct time and place.

So please contact your community team if there are any issues. You are our eyes and ears within the community and we cant do our jobs if we don't know about any issues
