FRAUD

Over the past couple of months, there have been reports of FRAUD being reported to ourselves.

These issues of FRAUD involve residents being contacted via their phone (either landline or mobile) and discussing their bank account, that their bank account had been involved in a scam.

Even if you question the person who has contacted you, they will provide reassurance and send a text message which states the bank you are banking with.

Once this has been done **THEY HAVE YOUR TRUST** and then will ask for information such as driving licence, bank details, passwords etc.

**** NEVER PROVIDE DETAILS TO SOMEONE OVER THE PHONE**

**** If there are real concerns about your bank account :**

- Tell them that you are hanging up the phone and will call the bank back (using the bank's official phone number, which can be found on bank cards)
- Head down to your bank in person and speak to someone in person

The next stage of the fraud, they will ask you to go onto your desktop / laptop computer or smart phone and download

***** ANY DESK *****

This is an app that allows someone control of your device. This is used by companies, but fraudsters are using this app and abusing it

They will then put up a different screen onto your device and work in the background getting access to your bank and then the FRAUD will take place.

Once again **DO NOT** provide details to someone calling you. **DO NOT** download an app called ANY DESK.

WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of ASB – dog being off the lead and jumping up at residents – PCSO to call for reassurance and more information, WEAVER VALE notified so that work together if required
- Report of Verbal abuse on social media – REPOSE dispatched and spoke to reporting person. Incident relates to an Ongoing issue. Safeguarding advice given as the comments were not direct – PCSO to call for reassurance

LEFTWICH

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of a Neighbour making remarks that states that she gave a blow job to her partner and possibly calling doctors in regards to her – PCSO Lee is involved in this neighbour dispute and has spoken to all parties and advice given
- Report off road bikes , motorbikes on CLIFTON DRIVE – Community team are aware of the issue and patrols are being conducted in regards
- Second report of males on Motor bikes doing wheelies— PC LOCK was dispatched , search made no trace
- Third report of off road bikes – PCSO to call for reassurance and plan of action. Name has now been given to someone who could be linked to this issue and they will be spoken to by the community team
- Suspicious Activity with a camper van opposite which could be in relation to a past incident – No Issues with camper van , all in order , PCSO To call for reassurance
- Report from a third person stating that they had received txt messages in regards to the person sending them was thinking of harming themselves – RESPONSE dispatched and spoke to the person who sent the txt messages and there was no sign of person harming
- Reporting person concerned about neighbour due to taxi arriving and not seeing her appear for the taxi driver – RESPONSE contacted the neighbour and all safe and well
- Report of the reporting person receiving threats – RESPONSE dispatched and spoke to the reporting person . PCSO to call for reassurance
- Report of a house party , which included a fight – female who wasn't involved hit – REPOSE DISPATCHED – suspected is being questioned in regards to this

KINGSMEAD

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Cause for concern over a male who reporting person has not heard from for a while who is a neighbour – RESPONSE sent out and male spoken to just not feeling well
- Number of youths throwing snowballs at RP window – RESPONSE sent out – Search made no trace of the youths – PCSO to call for reassurance
- Report of a Male who was attacked in REGENCY WAY CAR PARK – PCSO calling round for reassurance
- Report of persons son being attacked at school – PC LOCK and PCSO LEE called round and spoke to reporting person. Spoke to the school in regards to the issue and all parties been given words of advice and advised further issues will be looked into
- Report of a FEMALE walking in between and in front of cars – RESPONSE dispatched , FEMALE located and taken home
- Concern for a welfare check in regards to children who have not attended school – RESPONSE spoke to school and confirmed childrens whereabouts in regards to a family issue
- Report of two youths possibly smoking cannabis on the grass verge next to the riverbank – Logged as INTEL and beat team informed
- Report of possible harassment – RESPONSE dispatched and safeguarding advice given as there was no direct communication

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Ongoing parking issues that relates to ongoing neighbour issue – PC Lock and PCSO Lee attended
- Report of 2 vehicles blocking the road – both vehicles were moved – PCSO to make note of REGISTRATIONS and to patrol area to ensure wont happen again.

THEFT / FRAUD

- Report of FRAUD due to a person ringing up and stating that they were from the bank , and used the ANY DESK APP to take money from account—RESPONSE dispatched and safeguarding advice given. PCSO LEE to call round for further reassurance .

DAVENHAM

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of possible stalking – RESPONSE dispatch and investigating , PCSO Lee to call for reassurance

THEFT / BURGLARY

- Report of items being collected and the buyer stating that the items where paid for and provided a little extra for another item. SELLER provided the items and was told later that they had not been paid for – CRIMED and PCSO to call for reassurance
- Possibly intruders in house – RESPONSE dispatched and full search of property has been conducted – No one is in the building and there was no forced entry – PCSO To call for further reassurance
- Report of theft of jewellery – CRIMED – and RESPONSE dispatched.

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION

- Report a broken down vehicle blocking JACK LANE – REPSONSE dispatched no obstructions caused by the vehicle
- * Report of a illegally parked car – PCSO to conduct patrols and keep an eye out for the vehicle

MOULTON

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of verbal threats being made over the phone – Reporting person only wants to make a log of the issue
- Report of VERBAL ABUSE on social media towards the user – RESPONSE dispatched and advice given as it wasn't a directly aimed towards to the reporting person and language used is not an offence
- Report of a Male acting suspiciously on the reporting persons driveway, person states that they have ring door footage of a male trying the doors on their car that is parked on the drive - PCSO to call to obtain footage and see if the male can be identified
- Report of a male acting suspiciously walking up and down the pathways – RESPONSE dispatched – search made no trace – PCSO to call for further reassurance

THEFT

- Reporting person stating all mail had been stolen due to an issue with a cloned registration plate – CRIMED and PCSO to call for reassurance

BOSTOCK

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of a male sat at the side of the road , no coat on at night. – RESPONSE sent out Search made no trace of the male

MORE ACTION WITHIN THE COMMUNITY

DAY OF ACTION

On Thursday 30th November , approximately 40 officers from the Local Policing Unit conducted an number of warrants under Operation Narrating.

Officers raided four addresses in Northwich , one being an address in ARTISAN WAY.

From all 4 properties combined , approximately £10,000 in cash was seized as part of the day of action , as well as cannabis, THC edible gummies, nitrous oxide cannisters, pepper spray and small amounts of white powder

This day of action could not have been done without the help and support from our community , by communicating to us the potential issues that are happening within the community, by :

- reporting to 101
- Linking in with the community police (PC LOCK / PCSO LEE)
- Reporting anonymously to CRIME STOPPERS



OFF ROAD BIKES / QUAD BIKES

Over the past month there have been reports of a couple of issues which relate to ASB on OFFROAD BIKES / MOTORBIKES / QUAD BIKES.

In LEFTWICH there have been reports of youths on BIKES racing up and down CLIFTON DRIVE and doing wheelies on the road. Patrols have been occurring within the timescale that have been reported to 101, but unfortunately these issues have not been witnessed, as we do need either vehicle registration or names of those involved. Recently PCSO LEE has been given a name of a male who could be involved with this issue and this male will be spoken to in regards to this

In MOULTON there were reports from concerned residents of a parent picking up and dropping off a their child at school using a QUAD BIKE. This quad bike was being used on FOOTPATHS and ROADS. Again it would need to be witnessed to speak to the person involved. PCSO LEE conducted patrols and witnessed the issue occurring , in which PCSO LEE gave words of advice to the person involved. They were warned that QUAD BIKES are for private use only , cannot be used on footpaths and due to being on roads and if they have no INSURANCE / MOT they could be prosecuted, and in all aspects the vehicle could be seized.

MINI POLICE

Our MINI POLICE from KINGSMEAD got involved with their first community event by assisting the NORTHWICH SOUTH COMMUNITY TEAM at the NORTHWICH CHRISTMAS AWARDS. The MINI POLICE arrived at the station and spoke to all that attended , completed RESIDENTS VOICE SURVEYS with them and assisted giving out the awards to those who had earned them.
