## FRAUD

FRAUD is still a issue with the community and following from last months focus point and the advice given (please see last months newsletter, or DAVENHAM AND MOULTON POLICE dated 16/01/24) we would like to carry on talking about this.

With FRAUD on the increase all we can do at the present moment in time is to educate an prevent people falling victim to FRAUD.

We have been receiving reports of people getting phone calls from the POLICE asking for BANK DETAILS of the person who they are calling. They state on the phone that the Bank has been a subject to Data Breach / Fraud and are calling up to protect the person who they are calling. So they would ask for bank details (sort code / account number etc.) or even ask the person who they are calling to go and withdraw money.

### **THE POLICE WILL NEVER ASK FOR YOUR BANK DETAILS OR EVEN ASK YOU TO WITHDRAW MONEY**

If you do receive a call from the someone who say they are POLICE and they start asking you questions about your bank / money .. HANG UP.

And to reassure yourself call 101 saying you had a MALE / FEMALE calling saying they are police and are calling to see if this is genuine. The control board (101) will then shout up to all officers to see if anyone has been in touch. And you will be told if this was genuine or not

## WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

### ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report from the Ambulance service in regards to a FEMALE who had stabbed herself—RESPONSE , PC LOCK ,PO PELOW and PCSO ROBERTSON dispatched. REPONSE and PCS assisted with Medics and PCSO reassured neighbours. FEMALE was rushed to hospital.
- Report of nuisance / threatening messages—PCSO ROBERTSON completed a welfare check and safeguarding advice given. GREAT PLACES tenant , so therefore PCSO working with GREAT PLACES
- Report of suspicious activity from a Neighbour who fills up car with cans of DIESEL – Has been logged as intel

## LEFTWICH

### ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of a Male who is acting suspicious looking at cars in a car park—REPOSE DISPATCHED search of the male was unsuccessful. PCSO ROBERTSON called for reassurance , no further reports and no CCTV so can not ID the male
- Report of a Neighbour shouting abuse to another neighbour through CCTV—PCSO ROBERTSON dispatched , on going neighbour issue and both neighbours have been given safeguarding advice
- Report of a parent arriving at an address and forcing a child into a vehicle— RESPONSE dispatched and is an ongoing investigation
- Report of a neighbour making noises to antagonise the reporting persons dog and that an order which is in place is being broken by the neighbour—PCSO ROBERTSON dispatched and spoke to reporting person , there is no direct communication so order has not been broken , ongoing neighbour issue which is being monitored by community team.
- Report of a neighbour barking like a dog—PCSO ROBERTSON dispatched , reporting person notified can not stop people making noises in a PUBLIC PLACE , but if there is a noise complaint then CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER COUNCIL deal with this , so reporting person directed to the NOISE APP
- Report of a person breaking into the reporting persons property and that the reporting person is covered in blood—REPOSE and AMBULANCE dispatched

## FRAUD

- Report of messages being sent posing as a relative of the victim asking for money transfer in small amounts in numerous transactions . After money was sent Victim realised something was not right.—RESPONSE dispatched and safeguarding advice given , PCSO to call for a welfare / reassurance visit

## KINGSMEAD

### ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of messages being received from a third party saying that they will hurt themselves—REPOSNSE DISPATCHED to the address of the person who sent the messages , everything is ok and they have no intention to hurt themselves , no cause of alarm
- Report of two staff members who care for someone getting assaulted by the person – REPOSE dispatched and safeguarding advice given to the carers
- Report of a telephone call from the police in regards to the reporting persons partner being missing. This was suspicious as partner was NOT missing, when calling person was advised of this , person stated that they would call back and they haven't – PCSO to call for reassurance –

## DAVENHAM

### HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION

- Reporting of a car rolling down the road – RESPONSE DISPATCHED , search for the car was unsuccessful

### FRAUD

- Report of a MALE attending a shop and asking for money to be changed. The person waited for a busy time to cause some confusion. After the shop assistant changed the money , the male distracted the shop assistant and placed money up sleeve , then stated that they had not received the money—PCSO ROBERTSON called and gained CCTV , image of the male was posted out to other officers

## MOULTON

### ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of a neighbour being shouted at and given verbal abuse from an other neighbour—PCSO will be getting in contact with reporting person
- Reports of threats being made over the phone—On going issue which is being investigated by officers
- Report of a possible bullet being found whilst reporting person was out for a walk—FIREARMS informed

## JANUARY UPDATES



### Davenham and Moulton Police

#### LEFTWICH

- ASB on CLIFTON DRIVE due to YOUTHS—Patrols conducted after 21:00 , youths spotted hanging around the shop area , but moved on once spotted the police vehicle.
- More School Parking Patrols around the schools , not just LEFTWICH PRIMARY—School Parking patrols (when conducted in LEFTWICH) do cover both the PRIMARY and HIGH SCHOOL. In JANUARY 5 verbal advisories were issued

#### KINGSMEAD

- Parking issues on KENSINGTON WAY / KNIGHTSBRIDGE—Patrols are occurring and 1 advisory ticket was issued due to a vehicle parking too much on a footpath , therefore causing an issue for those using wheelchairs
- Parking issues, due to school parking—Patrols are occurring and cover DUKES WAY , REGAL CLOSE, WOBURN CLOSE , CALVERY CLOSE , BUCKINGHAM DRIVE and REGENCY WAY. 1 fixed penalty ticket was issued and MINI COPS will be introducing the MINI POLICE PARKING PROMISE

#### DAVENHAM

- Parking issues with the village — Parking patrols are continuing and issues witness will be looked at. The patrol now includes—FIRTH FIELDS , HARTFORD ROAD , GREEN LANE, CHURCH ROAD.

#### MOULTON

- \* PARKING on BARLOW ROAD, MAIN ROAD , WHITLOW LANE and RAVENSCROFT— Patrols conducted and there was no issues

## KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE

This page will be dedicated to the KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE and what they have done within the community and plans going ahead.

### MINI POLICE IDS

Now that the MINI POLICE has attended the Attestation and gained their hats, there was one thing missing and that is their official ID's. PCSO ROBERTSON asked the mini police if they wanted official ID's or to put their own spin on them and create them. Everyone voted to design their own ones which was their first task along with the news that the next task would be an ice breaker and that would be the BLEEP TEST.



### BLEEP TEST



All police officers before they start their training and become PCSO's or PC's have to take on the BLEEP TEST and achieve a set goal to pass that part of the training. So this was given to the MINI POLICE as their first task / challenge.

The official distance was measured and the track set up and all 21 MINI POLICE took on the bleep test and achieve some great scores. After taking on the bleep test the 1st time all 21 MINI POLICE wanted to beat their own scores and challenge PCSO ROBERTSON. So All 21 MINI POLICE completed a 2nd BLEEP TEST and smashed their first scores and some even beat PCSO ROBERTSON (even though he did it 2 times in a row).

### BLEEP TEST RESULTS AND IDS

After completing the BLEEP TEST, PCSO ROBERTSON gave them their certificates for completing the challenge. Along with listening to do the community and helping the community, the MINI POLICE program is also to give them LIFE SKILLS, GROW IN CONFIDENCE. With that certificates will be given to them when they achieve something and at the end of their time in a program a portfolio will be given to them to show they what they achieved and take that with them.



Together with the certificates, their own IDS were given to them, with their own designs and the MINI POLICE LOGO

### MINI POLICE PARKING PROMISE

In February the MINI POLICE will be setting up the PARKING PROMISE. Due to the RESIDENT VOICE surveys showing that RESIDENTS are having issues with parking especially at SCHOOL PICK UP TIMES, the parking promise will be set up.

The parking promise will consist of :

- A classroom session to teach the Mini Police on the best places to park, the issues bad parking can do. So this can be passed to their own family
- A leaflet that will be designed by the Mini Police, showing past examples of bad parking (from the DAVENHAM AND MOULTON FACEBOOK PAGE) and where to park and where not to park. Which will be given by the Mini Police to ALL PARENTS
- Engaging with all parents to see where they park and ask the parents if they think that is good or bad parking and seeing how the parents answer.
- Join PCSO ROBERTSON on patrols and issue tickets to any bad parking that is witnessed and a "THANK YOU FOR PARKING SAFELY" ticket to those vehicles that are not causing an obstruction.

These patrols will cover the areas that have been raised in the RESIDENTS VOICE—

Dukes Way, Monarch Drive, Regal Close, Castlemead Walk, Regency Way, Woburn Close and Calveley Close
