We are receiving reports through out the community of DRUG RELATED ISSUES. These may include :

- Possible drug dealings , due to suspicious behavior
- Drug usage including Cannabis

When we receive these reports they all go to INTELLIGENCE and the more reports / Intelligence we received , the bigger the picture we can build. As our main priority is to catch those who have drugs in their possession and to reduce / help those who use.

## WE NEED YOU !!

Our residents are our eyes and ears and without reports to 101 or intel (provided to your community officers) we cant build this picture up to catch those we need to catch.

If we conduct patrols of possible areas that Drug Dealing may be happening , then this will simply more the issue to another location within our community. Where as if we have a bigger picture we can put a plan of action into place.

 WE ACT -- Operation took place tonight and one male was arrested on suspicion of being concerned of supplying CLASS B drugs.  
 We urge the public to continue to work with the police in order to tackle these issues within the community.



Last year a report was made of suspicious activity around the KINGSMEAD area which could be linked to drugs. The community police worked with residents as they supplied, PC Lock and PCSO Robertson intelligence, which then led to an arrest.

When a report is made, PCSO Robertson will complete a reassurance visit and gain more information, which would be filled as Intelligence. With that the reporting person would be supplied with PCSO Robertsons EMAIL ADDRESS, so if there is further information it can be passed via email. So if there are issues please report them to 101 and if there are further issues relating please email your community police.

## WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

### ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of a possible dangerous dog in the communal area—Reporting person was contacted by another COMMUNITY TEAM PC and reassurance given—PCSO ROBERTSON notified of the issue and will speak to the owner of the dog.
- 2 x Reports of possible fuel being stolen and used privately and is being stored in a public area—PCSO ROBERTSON has alerted WEAVER VALE HOUSING and all reports have been placed as INTEL. And PCSO ROBERTSON has contacted the reporting person in regards to this

## LEFTWICH

### ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of youths being drunk and aggressive, whilst the reporting person was walking past them—Did not want to make a complaint , just informing the police—PCSO ROBERTSON called for reassurance , there has been no further issues
- Report of Males trying to gain access to reporting persons vehicle—PCSO ROBERTSON to call for further details and reassurance
- Report of a neighbour shouting abuse—PCSO ROBERTSON contacted reported person , wants the issue logged and neighbour spoken to if issue carries on
- Report of noises of things being smashed in the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING—PCSO ROBERTSON to check the location and see if its still secure. Location was unsecure and PCSO ROBERTSON contacted CWAC to ensure the building is secure.
- Report of OFF ROAD BIKES being driven on footpaths—Logged in as INTEL and patrols are being conducted
- Report that reporting persons son was walking home from school and got hit by another youth—PCSO ROBERTSON called for reassurance and RESPONSE officers attended.
- Report of an incident that occurred within LEFTWICH HIGH SCHOOL where one student attacked reporting persons son, school advised reporting person to contact police in regards to this—PC LOCK and PCSO ROBERTSON were also contacted in regards to this by reporting person. Spoke to the victim who would just like it be logged just incased anything else happens. Safeguarding advice was given as well.
- Report of a male following the reporting person home—PCSO ROBERTSON to call round for reassurance, there has been no further issues and the male has been identified.
- Report over concern over messages Reporting Persons daughter was receiving on TIK TOK—PCSO ROBERTSON to attend for reassurance and safeguarding advice. RESPONSE officers also attended.

### HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Report of a vehicle parking fully on footpath—PCSO alerted to the issue and area placed on patrol plan

## KINGSMEAD

### ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of two males on OFF ROAD BIKES—RESPONSE dispatched and SEARCH made , no trace of the males. Reporting person was contacted by officer and contact details were given as officer stayed in area , no further reports. PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance
- Report of a Male carrying a PEN KNIFE , dropped it and picked up straight away , no further concerns—PCSO to call for a CCTV enquiry to see if we can ID the male
- Report of possible harassment from a neighbour and that they feel uncomfortable that the neighbour has CCTV.—RESPONSE attended the address and spoke to the reporting person— PC LOCK / PCSO ROBERTSON notified of the incident as could be a neighbour dispute
- Report due to some concern over a neighbour who is heard screaming and shouting— diverted to AMBULANCE
- Report of a group of youths , throwing stones near TESCO—No reporting persons details so PCSO cant do a follow up , and no further reports in regards to this

### HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Report of neighbours driving over reporting persons land and causing parking issues.—PCSO ROBERTSON has been notified of the issue.
- Report of a CAMPERVAN parked on the footpath and linked to possible drugs—RESPONSE dispatched and search of the campervan conducted—Items were found and therefore owner given a COMMUNITY RESOLUTION ORDER

### THEFT

- Report of oil being taken from the front of the property—CRIMED and PCSO ROBERTSON to call round in regards for reassurance and safeguarding

### THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE

- Report of a dashboard being ripped off and wires cut. Steering wheel and radio had been taken , REPORTING PERSON had no CCTV— CRIMED—PCSO ROBERTSON to look into doing house to house for CCTV

## DAVENHAM

### ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of youths playing loud music at approx. 2am within the BUTCHERS STILE area—Further call from reporting person , that the youths have moved on— PCSO ROBERTSON will look at the CCTV to see if there is anyone that can be identified—unfortunately can not be identified due to distance away from CCTV. Have been made aware that could be residents from MOUNT PLEASANT ROAD
- Report of youths throwing items into the reporting persons garden from BUTCHERS STILE—PCSO ROBERTSON will look at the CCTV to see if there is anyone that can be identified
- Report of possible harassment from a neighbour , which is an ongoing issue. PCSO ROBERTSON attended last year and spoke to both neighbours as it is a neighbour dispute.— PCSO ROBERTSON has spoken to reporting person and they would like the neighbour spoken to , in which RESPONSE are now involved due to ongoing neighbour issue

## MOULTON

### ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of males in balaclavas banging on reporting persons door—PCSO to attend for reassurance—ongoing issue which RESPONSE and PC LOCK / PCSO ROBERTSON are aware of.

### THEFT

- Report of images being sent / hacked from a social media app after only speaking to the person for a couple of days. And then being asked for money before these images were sent to everyone—PCSO has called round for safeguarding as this issue of ONLINE FRAUD is an issue.
- Report of a third party gaining access to an online account and purchasing items—Online account was contacted and 1/2 of the order was cancelled however other 1/2 was collected—PCSO to call for reassurance—CCTV has been obtained by another PCSO (due to the item being collected in another area)
- Report of a youth bring a knife into school— PC LOCK / PCSO ROBERTSON have attended school , safeguarding is in place by the school , and POLICE / PCSO are happy that school have dealt with the issue.

### THEFT FROM A MOTOR VEHICLE

- Report of a possible abandoned vehicle on a private car park being broken into and vandalized.– PCSO ROBERTSON completed a reassurance visit and has obtained footage of the males involved and has been sent to WARRINGTON police officers to see if they can ID

## KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE—FEBURARY

This month the KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE started to set up the PARKING PROMISE. This is where the MINI POLICE would conduct patrols around the school area due to the issues that there is in regards to parking.

With this they had a classroom session that was conducted by PCSO ROBERTSON in which they learnt about :

- the surrounding area and the places where problem parking can happen
- What Residents are saying via the RESIDENTS VOICE SURVEY and reports to 101.
- The different types of parking , what is classed as good and bad parking.



After this they were set a challenge. First to come up with a MINI POLICE PARKING PROMISE LEAFLET that can be provided to all parents

Design two types of tickets , one for good parking “THANK YOU FOR PARKING SAFELY , and tickets for bad parking. Which all had to be designed by half term.

After the half term break the leaflets and tickets came back from the printers and the MINI POLICE were ready to launch the PARKING PROMISE.

On the 27/02/24 the MINI POLICE spoke to all parents who attended school to pick their loved ones up , by greeting them at the school gates and gave them the leaflets and advised them they would be patrolling over the course of the week.
