



# DAVENHAM AND MOULTON

May 2024 - 1st to 30th April

## ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR (ASB)

Over the Easter Period there was a number of reports of ASB within the community (KINGSMEAD , LEFTWICH) which involved a number of youths. The reports included :

- Youths knocking and running late at night and shouting abuse at the reporting person
- Youths throwing items at reporting persons house on a number of occasions
- Youths knocking onto address and causing a general disturbance and shouting abuse at the reporting person.

Within all cases , PCSO ROBERTSON attended the address and spoke to the reporting person offering advice and safeguarding as well as obtaining CCTV.

In all cases CCTV was available and obtained and in some cases further CCTV was needed , which was requested from other sources.

This CCTV is essential to identify all of those involved so that a police visit can be completed, in which the anyone who is involved can be spoken to with a parent or guardian present.

In one of the above cases , the youth causing the issue was identified and spoken to with parents present and advised them that if there was further issues regarding this then another police visit would occur.

We are still in the process of trying to obtain the other youths involved in the other cases,

In the past we have spoken to or even issued a COMMUNITY RESOLUTION ORDER to youths with the help of CCTV for the following :

- throwing items in the pond area in KINGSMEAD
- Shouting abuse at parents and teachers at pick up times at KINGSMEAD PRIMARY
- Causing a general disturbance on BUTCHERS STILE , in DAVENHAM

And patrols are even conducted in regards to ASB reports , as BUTCHERS STILE , LABURNUM ROAD PARK (DAVENHAM) , CLIFTON DRIVE , OLD HALL ROAD PLAY PARK (LEFTWICH) and DUKES WAY (KINGSMEAD) have all been on the community polices patrol plan.

So with this, if you are a victim of ASB or even see any types of ASB then please report them into 101

## WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

### ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of a dog constantly barking alongside a female screaming, reporting person doesn't know where this screaming is coming from —**RESPONSE officers dispatched , spoke to reporting person and conducted a patrol—there was no issues as nothing was heard**
- Report in which reporting person has concerns about a neighbour possibly stealing fuel—**WEAVER VALE have spoken to the neighbour and there is no concern about fuel being stolen**
- Report of neighbours possibly using CANNABIS—**Ongoing issue in which PCSO ROBERTSON and PC LOCK have been involved in. With this patrols will be increased which may lead to further house to house enquires and speaking to WEAVER VALE if any issues are witnessed. The last report about this was in JAN 24 , so reports have not been frequent to justify going to next stage already.**

## LEFTWICH

### ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report asking for a welfare check due to not being able to get in touch with someone who the reporting person has concerns about—**RESPONSE officers have spoken to the person and all is ok and telephone doesn't accept withheld numbers , reason why the reporting person couldn't get through.**
- Report of 20 youths being on the reporting persons driveway and causing issues—**RESPONSE officers contacted Reporting Person and the issue had stopped—PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**
- Report of a intoxicated female shouting abuse at people near the CLIFTON ROAD shops—**RESPONSE officers dispatched, female took home and told to stay there if not will be arrested for PUBLIC ORDER**
- Report of a FEMALE grabbing a teenagers bike by the handlebars and shouting abuse at them , not letting them go—**This has been crimed and RESPONSE officers are investigating this incident**
- Report of suspicious activity from a FEMALE who was trying to check into the PREMIER INN , but would not answer questions and was acting strange—**Information has been logged in INTEL**
- Report of a neighbour possible smoking CANNABIS—**Logged as INTEL , PCSO ROBERTSON to speak to reporting person in regards to obtaining more INTEL.**
- Report of a ongoing neighbour issue in which both parties have been told not to communicate with each other and this has been breached with the neighbour intimidating the reporting persons child— **PCSO ROBERTSON to attend as PC LOCK not available as both officers have been dealing with this issue**
- Report of a neighbour possibly drilling a hole through to their property, this has not been noticed straight away. The reporting person has spoke to the neighbour but is not taking responsibility for it - **PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**
- Report of threatening messages being sent via social media top reporting persons daughter—**Safeguarding advice given—PCSO to call for reassurance**
- Report of a female attending reporting persons address and being verbally aggressive— **Safeguarding advice given—PCSO to call for reassurance**
- Report of Youths throwing items at the reporting persons house—**PCSO to call for reassurance and CCTV enquires**

### HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Report of a branch being on LONDON ROAD which could cause issues .—**Local Council attended and cleared the obstruction**

## KINGSMEAD

### ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of two males with a dog acting suspiciously by going up and down residents driveways—**RESPONSE officers dispatched—SEARCH MADE NO TRACE**
- Report of a female going missing suddenly from home , reporting person tried to call mobile phone an d after a few attempts the female picked up. Female was having issues in relation to school bullying— **RESPONSE officers attended address and spoke to the female and parents and gave safeguarding advice in relation to the bullying issue. PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**
- Report of a male stabbing himself in the hand—**AMBULANCE called and male sent to hospital**
- Report of concern over a neighbour not being seen for a couple of days—**The neighbour has been seen**
- Report of youths causing issues , by doing knock and run and intimidating behaviour—**PCSO to attended reporting persons address and collect the CCTV of the incident**
- Report of a male knocking on reporting persons door and accusing him of inappropriate behaviour—**PCSO to attend for a reassurance visit**

### HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Report of a broken down vehicle in a dangerous position—**RESPONSE dispatched and vehicle was not in a dangerous position and vehicle was recovered.**
- Report of a broken down vehicle by the traffic lights— **Vehicle was recovered .**
- Report of vehicles causing issues by parking over driveways and double parking on WYNDHAM CLOSE—**PCSO ROBERTSON is aware of this issue and patrols are being conducted**

## DAVENHAM

### ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of Dog attack. Reporting person was out walking a dog and walked past another dog walker and the reporting persons dog went to approach the other dog , and that dog bit the reporting persons dog—**PCSO to call for reassurance**
- Report from the other dog walker in regards to the dog attack—stating that the other dog walker had no control over their dog and it approached and bit the reporting persons dog twice—**PCSO to call for reassurance**
- Report of a male being aggressive to female care workers at DAVENHAM HALL—**Assigned to response officers**

# MOULTON

## ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report due to concerns about a neighbour as not seen or heard from them in a couple of days , have looked through window and rang mobile and theres no answer.— **RESPONSE officers have attended address as ambulance was called as well , unfortunately the neighbour had passed away.**
- Report of a MALE contacting the reporting person over social media. This was an issue 4 years ago which related to harassment , therefore police got involved and since then no issues, until now.— **REPOSE officers are investigating this.**
- Report of a MALE being abusive to a shop worker—**Has been CRIMED, PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**
- Report of possible harassment as Reporting person has been accused of something and was verbally shouting at— **PCSO to call for reassurance**
- Report of an AMAZON driver assaulting reporting person—**PCSO to call for reassurance**

- Report of a abandoned vehicle that is causing an obstruction on JACK LANE—**Response have been dispatched and the vehicle was removed.**

When the event was opened the MINI POLICE completed the bike marking on their own with supervision from the PCSOs

Over the course of the two hours the MINI POLICE marked a total of 26 bikes.
