LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING

The LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING which is opposite OLD HALL ROAD and just off KINGSLEY DRIVE in LEFTWICH use to be a community support centre , which was owned and run by CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER and was for people who required assisted living.

Unfortunately over the years this building has been closed down by the council and is waiting for new owners to take over. With this the building is now out of use.

Last year there were break ins on a number of occasions which was reported to 101 and PCSO ROBERTSON , with this the building was placed onto the patrol plan and talks with CHESHIRE WEST AND CEHSTER about the building took place. The break ins were occurring due to the fact that the rear fencing had fallen down , so CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER COUNCIL boarded up all access points and made the fencing at the rear of the property more secure.

This did stop the break ins and the amount of reports declined and eventually there were no issues with this building, so with that the building did come of the patrol plan.

Unfortunately over the past couple of weeks reports have started again and there has been a number of officers who have attended the building and noticed new access points , due to the boarding up being damaged. On every occasion that officers have attended the access points had been made secure again , by calling out emergency boarding up. PCSO ROBERTSON has placed the building back on the patrol plan and with this any one spotted in or around the area will be questioned.

This building is a health hazard and this is the main reason for these patrols as the building inside is not safe with live wires coming from the ceiling , glass and other items that could cause injury. So this again is the main reason why this building is the main focus of your community police at this current moment in time.

PCSO ROBERTSON has contacted CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER COUNCIL and SAFTEY OFFICERS in regards to making the building more secure.

We do ask if anyone knows of anyone who is entering this building, we do advise that THEY MUST NOT due to mainly their safety.

If there is any suspicious activity around the building then please call it into 101.

WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Reports—Ongoing reports of suspicious behaviour of a neighbour bringing FUEL back and storing it—**PCSO has contacted landlord , WEAVER VALE in regards to this. They have spoken to tenant and update given to PCSO who has passed this to the reporting person**
- Report of a male on all fours as it looks like he has had a fall— **name and taken and located where the male lived , which was a care home. Care home was notified and staff came and collected him**
- Report of suspicious behaviour in regards to a neighbour pouring fuel from a large container into their vehicle—**PCSO has contacted WEAVER VALE in regards to this , who have spoken to resident, nothing suspicious as there is no evidence it is stolen and only concern is where this fuel stored.**
- Report of youth sending voice messages and images to another youth , which parent is concerned about— **RESPONSE attended , safeguarding advice has been given , PCSO called for reassurance. Has attended school to talk about issues like this. No further issues**

- Report of vehicles blocking footpath in the area surrounding VERDIN HOUSE—**PCSO will be looking into this and dealing with any obstructions witnessed**

- Report of a neighbour being shouting abuse which relates to dog causing a mess in the garden—**PCSO to call for reassurance**
- Report of an assault in a PUBLIC AREA—**PCSO was already in area when report came in , attended and spoke to Victims , PCS arrived and carried on speaking to the victims , PCSO ROBERTSON attended local business to see if there was CCTV**
- Report of youths breaking into the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING—**RESPONSE dispatched and area searched no trace and no possible ways into building**
- A further report on a following day regarding youths breaking into the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING—**not dispatched as youths left area whilst reporting person was on the call**
- A third report on a separate day in regards to the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING— **PCSO has been notified to place area on patrol plan**
- Report of youths making a lot of noise on the field behind the Reporting persons address—**Call was made at 1530 which is not un-sociable—report was made out of area**
- 2nd report of youths causing issues on a field behind reporting persons address—**Call was made 1630 , which is not un-sociable—PCSO to call round for reassurance**
- Report of 2 female youths knocking on door and acting suspiciously—**PCSO to call for reassurance and seeing if there is CCTV**
- Report of a FEMALE walking down the street and shouting “IM GONNA F**KING KILL YOU” and she is with children and possibly under the influence— **No further reports and a ANON call so PCSO cant get any further info**
- Report of a group of youths causing a disturbance at 2230pm , climbing on garages—**RESPONSE dispatched—Search made no trace**
- Report in regards to concern over children being left alone at home—**RESPONSE attended—no cause for concern as parent was home**
- Report of a bike and fence panels being set alight—**ongoing issues with the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING—PCSO ROBERTSON is in touch with CWAC in regards to this , PATROLS occurring**
- Report of a neighbour filming reporting person—**Ongoing neighbour dispute which PC LOCK and PCSO ROBERTSON are dealing with**

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Report of a vehicle being parked on the edge of PRIORY AVE next the to the junction of LONDON ROAD—**PCSO has placed this area back on patrol plan**

KINGSMEAD

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of someone jumping into RIVER WEAVER and has not come back up— **RESPONSE attended**
- Report of a child throwing a bottle at a window whilst inside her own home—**Not a police matter as inside her own home**
- Report of Male acting suspiciously and in the same van that has been mentioned in a facebook post— **PCSO to call for reassurance—vehicle details have been noted**
- 5x reports in regards to the suspicious van driving around the community and taking pictures — **Registrations that are given to us have been passed to PC LOCK / PCSO to call for reassurance. Details entered into ANPR and tracked.**

DAVENHAM

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of male approaching reporting persons daughter whilst in his car and asked her to get in , which she didn't—**RESPONSE attended and No lines of enquiry so logged—PCSO called round for reassurance and safeguarding advice given. No further reports of issues relating to this**
- Report over concern due to illness. Reporting person was stating that he was being removed from his own house by nurses over partners complaints.—**RESPONSE attended , there was no assaults and both parties are suffering from medical conditions - safeguarding advice given**
- Further report in regards to the above incident stating that the reporting person can not control their partner—**PCSO to call for reassurance or to contact family members**
- Report of two youths throwing parking cones into LONDON ROAD—**PCSO to call to see if there is CCTV of the incident**
- Report of youths causing issues on BUTCHERS STILE at 0130am—**RESPONSE dispatched and advised youths to keep noise down as the area is public grounds , youths did move on**
- 2nd Report in regards to youths causing an issue on BUTCHERS STILE— **see above and PCSO has been alerted to the issue and will check CCTV**

- Report of an altercation within the TRAVELLERS REST—**RESPONSE are looking into this**

- Report of a dog possibly being taken when the dog left the home address and followed owners , dog didn't come back— **CRIMED**

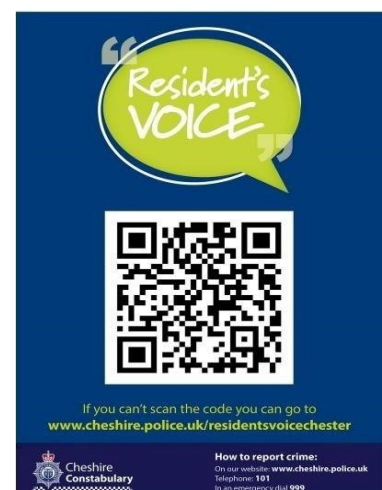

LETS WALK TRAINING

The MINI POLICE undertook their LETS WALK TRAINING this month. The LETS WALK TRAINING training teaches :

- Crossing the road safely
- Crossing a busy road safely
- what not to do when crossing a road
- Crossing the road when there are obstructions and parked vehicles

This training was conducted due to the fact that the MINI POLICE noticed that there was issues when children / parents leave school which include:

- Not using the footpath crossing
- Running across roads
- Walking in the middle of the road

Now that the MINI POLICE have conducted their training , the MINI POLICE will now assist PCSO ROBERTSON in training the younger children, starting with year 4.



NATIONAL ARMED FORCES FLAG RAISING CEREMONY
