

COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER DAY – KINGSMEAD WEEDING

The Parish Council understands that many residents are frustrated with the lack of maintenance carried out by Cheshire West and Chester Council in and around our community. CW&C is responsible for the maintenance of our roundabouts, along with all paths and highways and some of our grass verges (e.g. at Duke's Way and the corner of Monarch Drive).

We would like to help improve this situation, and earlier this year we agreed in principle with CW&C to adopt the crown hedge roundabout and take over the management of its grass cutting and hedge trimming. This conversation is ongoing but we hope to conclude it soon, after which, we will be looking to return the roundabout to its former glory.

In the meantime, we are also proposing a COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER DAY to tackle some of the overgrown weeds that are growing in paths and along road edges. The parish council can provide suitable equipment (hoes, bin bags, high-viz jackets, etc) and all green waste will be removed by us.

Most importantly, we need YOUR help to make Kingsmead a tidier place for everyone to live, so please come along and join us in our campaign.
