## ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR (ASB) around the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING

As you can see inside in this edition of the community newsletter , there has been a number of issues with youths gaining entry and causing ASB issues around the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING.

PCSO ROBERTSON has been in touch with CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER COUNCIL and NORTHWICH TOWN COUNCIL in regards to the building. They have advised PCSO ROBERTSON that the building will be patrolled twice weekly by an outside company to ensure that the building remains secure.

PCSO ROBERTSON last patrolled the area on the 21st August before he went on to leave and the building was secure , and with the information that he was passed , PCSO ROBERTSON had in mind that this would not be an issue.

However upon his return there has been a number of issues relating to youths throwing items at windows trying to smash them , and gaining entry into the grounds and gaining entry to the roof area.

RESPONSE and COMMUNITY OFFICERS have attended and on a number of occasions the youths have ran off, however on one occasion one male was ARRESTED and one male and one female were SEARCHED and taken home.

Due to the amount of issues a DISPERSAL ORDER was placed on the LEFTWICH AREA which meant any youths in the area would be ordered to leave the area , if not they would be arrested. Which we are pleased to say these were NOT from the community.

PCSO ROBERTSON has again been told that the building is secure by the COUNCIL, however PCSO ROBERTSON will leave the area on his patrol plan and any youths that are spotted in the area , may be subjected to a STOP SEARCH and ordered to leave the area.

# KEEP YOUR HOME AND VEHICLE SAFE

This month we have had an issue with a vehicle being stolen from a property in KINGSMEAD and a failed attempt on the same day in LEFTWICH.

In both incidents there was entry to the property with damaged being caused and unfortunately due to accessibility of the car keys , the vehicle was taken.

The area was attended by RESPONSE , CID and COMMUNITY OFFICERS to look into this crime , with PCSO ROBERTSON as part of the COMMUNITY OFFICER providing safeguarding advice on how to keep homes safe.

It is still surprising that many people leave doors unlocked and keys in locks, and keys on show.

We are entering the AUTUMN / WINTER period which brings us darker nights , so this advice is important.

## HOME SECURITY :

- When leaving the home , simply shutting the door wont prevent burglaries , double—lock the door every single time you leave the house.
- Don't leave keys in door locks
- Don't leave valuables on show
- If possible protect your home with CCTV such as RING DOOR CAMERAS. RING DOOR CAMERAS don't have to go onto doors , they can also go on walls
- Mark your property with property marking kits , and advertise this has been done by placing stickers on windows and doors

## VEHCILE SAFETY

- Lock your vehicle every time you leave the vehicle unattended.
- Don't leave keys in the ignition even if your unloaded the vehicle
- Don't leave the keys on show , keep them secure (in a drawer , coat pocket) so they are not on show
- If your selling your car , DO NOT let the keys leave your sight

## WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

### ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Reporting person started speaking to a person online , sent images and now the reporting person is being asked for money to stop these images being distributed—**PCSO to call round for reassurance**
- Report of verbal threats to a 10 year old males from other children—**PCSO to call round for reassurance**
- Further reports in regards to neighbour filling his vehicle from a plastic container—**has been filed as INTEL as has been investigated by PCSO / WEAVER VALE**

## LEFTWICH

### ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of Neighbours causing a noise disturbance at in the early hours of the morning—**RESPONSE OFFICERS attended and spoke to the persons involved to keep the noise down.**
- A further report of neighbours causing noise issues— **Safeguarding advice given as this is a COUNCIL ISSUE**
- Report of a 10 year old male hitting reporting persons son , which is linked to issues at school—**PCSO to call round for reassurance**
- Report of a female being aggressive outside reporting persons door , which is linked to previous report—**PCSO to call for reassurance**
- Report of a female being aggressive after a house party - **Reporting person didn't want to make an official complaint—PCSO called for reassurance and everything is ok now.**
- Report of a fight which is occurring with about 8 people in front of reporting persons address—**RESPONSE officers dispatched , everyone has left the area**
- Report of screaming and shouting at 2am from a neighbours address— **RESPONSE officers attended address.**
- Report of a fire being lit in back garden of residence after a late night party—**RESPONSE attended**
- Report of youths smashing windows and trying to gain access to LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING—**PCSO ROBERTSON has completed patrols and building is secure. CWAC are completing twice weekly patrols to ensure building is kept secure**
- Report of youths hiding behind reporting persons vehicle on driveway— **due to issues in the area , Reporting person was advised to report any suspicious behaviour—PCSO to call for reassurance**
- Report of people being loud , who are next door to the reporting person— **RESPONSE attended , people getting excited watching a UFC fight , been advised to keep noise down.**
- Report of intimidating behavior from a neighbour in regards to boundaries and a threat that has been posted—**Reporting person has been given safeguarding advice and has been in touch with PCSO ROBERTSON about how to tackle this issue**
- Report of a female knocking on reporting persons door and demanding items , whilst threatening the person as well—**Safeguarding advice given as this incident happened the previous night , PCSO to call for reassurance**
- Report of loud noises and frequent comings and goings from different people which is unusual. Plus there is a smell of cannabis—**PCSO to call reporting person via telephone to discuss and get an INTEL link**
- Report of youths causing issues near the shop area of CLIFTON DRIVE—**PCSO not available and no available RESPONSE officers**
- Report of a male running out of TAXI and not paying—**TAXI company has sorted this issue as the male left belongings and paid**
- Report of youths gaining access to the COMMUNITY BUILDING—**RESPONSE officers attended and CWAC have been alerted to ensure the building is secure**
- Report of a male turning up at the PREMIER INN and demanding to search every room due to the FIND MY PHONE app states his phone is there and then being aggressive when staff would not let him—**Due to security , male was not allowed access—PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**

## LEFTWICH (cont)

### ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN (cont)

- Report of youths causing issues for reporting person—**RESPONSE officers attended—Search made no trace and the reporting person did not answer door when officers called for further information**
- 3 Further reports in regards to the COMMUNITY BUILDING , youths gaining access to the building — **RESPONSE officers attended and youths ran off—CWAC again notified that they must secure the building**
- Further report in regards to youths causing issues on CLIFTON ROAD—**PCSO ROBERTSON to call to see if CCTV has captured the youths so can be identified.**
- Further report in regards to COMMUNITY BUILDING—youths now outside throwing items at windows—**information has been passed to PCSO ROBERTSON—area is on patrol plan when back on duty**
- Further report in regards to the COMMUNITY BUILDING—youths now on top of building throwing items down—**RESPONSE officers attended and one male ARRESTED and two more SEARCHED and taken home**

### BURGLARY

- \* Report of a shed being broken into and items taken—**Has been crimed**

### THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

- Report of a rear doors of property being damaged and side gate being opened to try and get access to property— **Failed attempt to get vehicle . RESPONSE attended , and completed House to house to alert neighbours. PCSO notified by PC's. PCSO ROBERTSON completed reassurance visit. Social Media / Cheshire alert message sent out**

## KINGSMEAD

### ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of nuisance calls which led to a threat—**PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance to see if ongoing , and pass on safeguarding advice / reassurance as sounds like a SCAM call and threat was due to SCAMMER not getting what they wanted**
- Report of reporting person being pushed after kicking / or motion to kick another persons dog, as out for a walk and dog was being aggressive—**PCSO ROBERTSON to speak to reporting person about the incident as incident could have been adverted if there was not a kick**
- Report of a male walking up reporting persons path which has been caught on RING DOOR CAM— **PCSO ROBERTSON to speak with reporting person and to view footage.**
- Report of two males asking about driveways and acting suspiciously paying attention to certain properties—**information about the vehicle has been placed into INTEL. PCSO ROBERTSON to call to see if there has been further sightings**

### THEFT

- Report of reporting person being blackmailed for money after being filmed without their acknowledgement—**Another online scam incident involving fulfilling requests for people don't know fully—PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**

### THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

- Report of a rear doors of property being damaged and side gate being opened to try and get access to property and vehicle taken— **RESPONSE and CID attended.PCSO notified by PC's. PCSO ROBERTSON completed reassurance visit and House to house to alert neighbours. Social Media / Cheshire alert message sent out**

## DAVENHAM

### ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of a customer being aggressive due to the fact that they had no means of payment , threatening staff members— **officer had contacted Reporting person , customer paid and everything is now ok. PCSO to call for reassurance**
- Report of stones being placed behind reporting persons car tyres—**PCSO ROBERTSON to call to enquire if there is CCTV / Reassurance**

## MOULTON

### ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of concern over neighbours activities— **PCSO to call reporting person via telephone to gain more information**

### THEFT

- Report of possible blackmail as reporting person son started to speak to someone online and sent images of themselves and being asked for money to stop these being distrusted—**PCSO to call for reassurance—failed to get in touch**
- Report of messages being received by the reporting person demanding money , or else embarrassing pictures will be posted online— **PCSO to call for reassurance**

## BOSTOCK

### CAUSE FOR CONCERN

\* Report of a young child not breathing —**AMBULANCE called , appears child fell off the high seat. Child was crying when AMBULANCE arrived , may have been knocked out and had an episode of Breathe holding**

## DAVENHAM AND MOULTON on FACEBOOK

### FUNDING PROVIDED TO SIR JOHN DEANES COLLEGE FOR TRAFFIC CONES

From APRIL this year the residents surrounding the SIR JOHN DEANES COLLEGE area were having issues with parking and drivers stopping to pick up their loved ones from college , causing issues such as :

- Double parking
- Parking on private land
- Parking on junctions
- Parking on bends

And a reason for this is the number of cones that SIR JOHN DEANES COLLEGE place out have decreased due to damage and wear and tear.

Due to residents reports and feedback and with SIR JOHN DEANES working together with RESIDENTS and PCSO ROBERTSON , they spoke to PCSO ROBERTSON in regards to possibly getting more cones to try and tackle this issue.

PCSO ROBERTSON contacted CRIMEBEAT who provide funding for community projects which is gained from proceeds of crime.

After submitting the request and explaining the benefits of what the funding can do , the funding was approved and 30 traffic cones were provided to SIR JOHN DEANES , which are for the sole purpose of tackling the parking issues on , MONARCH DRIVE and WYNDHAM CLOSE.

PCSO ROBERTSON will be conducting parking patrols around the area and will be speaking to residents in the upcoming weeks to see if the issue of parking has improved.

## WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

- More Patrols in area as there is ASB issues
- Safeguarding people from social media bullying—**Safe guarding advice has been provided on our Social Media Channels and to people who bring it to our attention**

## LEFTWICH

- Speed Monitoring on CLIFTON DRIVE / DUNHAM ROAD / LONDON ROAD (30MPH SECTION) and LIME AVE
- More Visibility around WOODPECKER DRIVE area / GRANVILLE ROAD area
- Extend the school parking patrols to WOODSIDE TERRACE area— **is now included in the school parking patrols**
- Issues with OFF ROAD BIKES— **Owner of the BIKE has been spoken to and warned if witnessed again, bike may be seized**
- More PATROLS around the play parks due to ASB— **latest incident being looked into 3 female youths have been identified and house visits will be conducted.**
- More patrols around the shops due to ASB issues - **CLIFTON DRIVE is included in the SUMMER ASB PATROLS that PCSO ROBERTSON is conducting**

## KINGSMEAD

- Parking patrols on REGENCY WAY just after the ROUNDABOUT— **Parking patrols have been conducted by MINI POLICE**
- Speed Monitoring on REGENCY WAY and DUKES WAY—**Will be included in the MINI POLICE PROGRAM**
- School Parking patrols extend to MONARCH DRIVE—**Now included in the school parking patrol**
- More Patrols around REGENCY WAY RETAIL PARK
- Littering from the students that attend SIR JOHN DEANES
- Anti Social Behaviour issues around the community—**Please report any issues to 101, over the summer there has been no issues of ASB**
- Parking patrols around WYNDHAM CLOSE— **Parking patrols will be conducted at the start of term in SEPTEMBER**

## DAVENHAM

- Speed Monitoring on MOUNT PLEASANT / FOUNTAIN LANE / LONDON ROAD (20 MPH SECTION) / HARTFORD ROAD) and CHURCH ROAD at commuter times
- Provide events / things to do for the youths in the community—**Football sessions have been set up in AUGUST**
- More Parking patrols around the area
- Issues with OFF ROAD BIKES / ELECTRIC SCOOTERS around JACK LANE—**One electric scooter has been seized with the community**
- Parking issues around THE PAVILLIONS junction of HARTFORD ROAD / EATON LANE—**FIXED PENALTY TICKETS have been issued to those vehicles that cause issues**
- Bring up issues relating to CANNANBIS to WEAVER VALE—**Are in touch with WEAVER VALE and will raise this up again**
- Parking Issues at the top of CHURCH ROAD / junction of LONDON ROAD—**Vehicles that have been witnessed causing issues (which mainly are linked to parking on double yellow lines to attend the pharmacy) will be issued FIXED PENALTY TICKETS**
- Parking on LONDON ROAD and LABURNUM ROAD—**Any issues witnessed on LONDON ROAD will be issued with FIXED PENALTY TICKETS as it's the main road PCSO ROBERTSON uses to get to MOULTON. So LONDON ROAD is being patrolled. LABURNUM ROAD is a private road so parking can not be addressed.**
- Vehicle blocking / obstructing junction—PRITCHARD DRIVE— **on patrol plan as HARTFORD ROAD is already on patrol plan**
- **20MPH Signage is in the wrong areas as there is a lot of speeding in the area—NEW—We are in the process of restarting community speed watch**

- Issues with OFF ROAD BIKES / ELECTRIC SCOOTERS around JACK LANE—One electric scooter has been seized within the area

- Speed Monitoring on LONDON ROAD

## SCHOOL / COLLEGE PARKING — (80 Vehicles causing issues between SEP 23— JULY 24)

Over the past school year over 80 vehicles were given even VERBAL advisories (IF DRIVERS PRESENT) or FIXED PENALTY TICKETS, this also includes patrols conducted by the MINI POLICE.

### KINGSMEAD— 55 issues (including MINI POLICE patrols)

Including , parking in front of residents driveways , parking on double yellow lines and parking over the footpath crossing

### DAVENHAM— 12 issues

Including parking too close to junctions , parking over residents driveways

### LEFTWICH— 10 issues

Including parking too close to junctions , on the keep clear sections , parking across residents driveways

### MOULTON—3 issues

Including parking on double yellows , too close to junctions , on keep clear sections



## KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE—AUGUST

### THE MINI POLICE COURT IS NOW IN SESSION

When the MINI POLICE first had their interviews back in OCTOBER 23, one of the most requested patrols that the MINI POLICE wanted to conduct was in regards to SPEEDING.

With the MINI POLICE conducting SPEEDING SESSIONS this would involve them using the SPEED GUN on certain roads within KINGSMEAD.

Whilst waiting for a perfect time to conduct the SPEED GUN SESSION the MINI POLICE were asked if they would like to try a new type of patrol which could be implemented into the MINI POLICE PROGRAM, which is the MINI POLICE COURT

This involved the MINI POLICE working along side the COMMUNITY POLICE to do a SPEED / ROAD OPERATION.

This included PCSO with the SPEED GUN and if any vehicles were caught travelling over the speed limit , they would be pulled over by the PC's who would normally give them a fixed penalty notice together with fine , points or course (if applicable). However on this occasion the driver would be given a choice , to take the ticket or to attend KINGSMEAD SCHOOL within 10 minutes and attend the MINI POLICE COURT and face the MINI POLICE.

Drivers who attended MINI POLICE COURT would be asked by the MINI POLICE a number of questions, such as :

- did they know what speed they were going ?
- Did they know the speed limit of the road ?
- Why they were breaking the speed limit today ?

The MINI POLICE did a great job and spoke to drivers who were pulled over by breaking the speed limit on the A533. With the impact it had on the drivers the MINI POLICE COURT will be doing more sessions in the upcoming months

### MINI POLICE ATTEND THE TACTICAL TRAINING UNIT

Over the Summer PCSO ROBERTSON provided extra patrols for the MINI POLICE to attend which also included a visit to CHESHIRE CONSTABULARY HQ and the TACTICAL TRAINING UNIT.

The MINI POLICE that attended were shown :
