110 110.1	<p>Maintenance & Landscaping To consider quotes received from Caddis for the following works as appropriate:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Wheelock Close – management of boundary trees/hedge and removal of bamboo Resolved – that Caddis carry out the work at a cost of £980 + VAT. Work to be carried out in agreement with the adjacent neighbours. b) Regency Way – removal of the oak opposite 15 Mayfair Drive Resolved – that Caddis carry out the work at a cost of £1880 + VAT. c) Burwardsley Way – tree work adjacent to no.12 Resolved – that Caddis carry out the work at a cost of £1960 +VAT. d) Lavister Close – tree work adjacent to no.6 Resolved – to defer a decision to the October meeting e) Shavington Avenue – work tbc if necessary adjacent to no.36 Resolved – to defer a decision to the October meeting. f) Spine Road – work to an oak tree Resolved – to defer a decision pending further investigation of the works. Please also note that this work actually refers to a tree on Regency Way (adjacent to Bickerton Close) and NOT on the spine road. g) Wildflower strip on spine road – cut/flail this year’s flowers and harrow the land for planting Resolved – that Caddis carry out the works at a cost of £1280 + VAT and be instructed to complete the works as soon as possible when the weather allows. h) Coronet Avenue – maintenance of woodland strip / hedge line Resolved – to defer a decision to the October meeting. i) Play areas – management of trees adjacent to play equipment Resolved – to defer a decision to the October meeting. <p>110.2 To consider a quote received from Countrywide for the removal of ivy at Tatton Close and adjacent to the Kingsmead wall Resolved – to defer a decision on this work pending additional quotes.</p>
