ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR (ASB) issues around the CLIFTON DRIVE area.

As you will see inside this edition of the COMMUNITY NEWSLETTER , there has been a dramatic increase of ASB issues in the LEFTWICH AREA , especially around the CLIFTON ROAD AREA.

These reports included :

- youths playing loud music
- Youths swearing and being aggressive to residents and members of public
- Youths climbing drain pipes to bang on windows
- Youths intimidating members of public
- Youths kicking and damaging windows , bus shelters and shutters

This is a RESIDENTIAL AREA and everyone has a right to live in a area without distress or harm. A house to house was completed and spoke to all businesses and residents in relation to the two weeks in September when 20 reports were made to 101 in 2 weeks in regards to this. This is the reason why we have obtained CCTV footage and have completed identifying all those involved.

PCSO ROBERTSON will be contacting parents of all those who have been identified and will be speaking to all with parents present.

At the current moment in time , youths are being asked to move on from the area. PCSO ROBERTSON has spoken to a number of youths already who have respected what was asked from PCSO ROBERTSON and complied with him which we do thank as it is helping with the issue.

CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER COUNCIL have been notified all of the suggestions that residents and businesses provided to PCSO ROBERTSON to help make the area safer.

As the nights are getting earlier we would like to repeat what we stated last month , in regards to safeguarding .

KEEP YOUR HOME AND VEHICLE SAFE

This month we have had an issue with a vehicle being stolen from a property in KINGSMEAD and a failed attempt on the same day in LEFTWICH.

In both incidents there was entry to the property with damaged being caused and unfortunately due to accessibility of the car keys , the vehicle was taken.

The area was attended by RESPONSE , CID and COMMUNITY OFFICERS to look into this crime , with PCSO ROBERTSON as part of the COMMUNITY OFFICER providing safeguarding advice on how to keep homes safe.

It is still surprising that many people leave doors unlocked and keys in locks, and keys on show.

We are entering the AUTUMN / WINTER period which brings us darker nights , so this advice is important.

HOME SECURITY :

- When leaving the home , simply shutting the door wont prevent burglaries , double—lock the door every single time you leave the house.
- Don't leave keys in door locks
- Don't leave valuables on show
- If possible protect your home with CCTV such as RING DOOR CAMERAS. RING DOOR CAMERAS don't have to go onto doors , they can also go on walls
- Mark your property with property marking kits , and advertise this has been done by placing stickers on windows and doors

VEHCILE SAFETY

- Lock your vehicle every time you leave the vehicle unattended.
- Don't leave keys in the ignition even if your unloaded the vehicle
- Don't leave the keys on show , keep them secure (in a drawer , coat pocket) so they are not on show
- If your selling your car , DO NOT let the keys leave your sight

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of ONLINE ABUSE whilst on TIK TOK LIVE. - **PCSO ROBERTSON to call round for reassurance.**
- Report of a potential fraud—where as reporting person received a call from EE where as was told every £45 spent today , he would get a free iphone15— **PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**
- Report over threats being made to the reporting person—**Being assigned to RESPONSE officer to look into**
- Further report in regards to neighbour possibly stealing fuel from place he works—**information has been placed as INTEL and WEAVER VALE are aware of the issue**
- Report of a threat being made over social media—**safeguarding advice given and PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**
- Report of 3 youths causing issues on the BUILDING SITE—**All youths have been identified and PCSO ROBERTSON to speak to all concerned**
- Report of reporting person receiving threatening calls—**PCSO ROBERTSON to call round for reassurance , safe guarding advice given**

LEFTWICH

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Report of youths gaining access to the COMMUNITY BUILDING—**PCSO ROBERTSON is aware of this ongoing issue and is in with talks with CWAC and NORTHWICH TOWN to ensure this building is made more secure**
- Report in relation to ongoing neighbour issues—**Mediation for both parties is now being set up with PARTNER AGENCIES that both parties are required to attend**
- Further report of youths gaining access to the COMMUNITY BUILDING— **RESPONSE dispatched, youths ran off. Meeting occurred on 04/09/24 in regards to the building and extra security fencing is going up on 06/09/24 with a House to House being completed and Social Media messages.**
- Report of youths causing a fire behind reporting persons property— **RESPONSE OFFICERS and FIREFIGHTERS dispatched—when RESPONSE attended FIRE was out and youths had left the area.**
- Report of a fight outside Reporting Persons address—**RESPONSE officers dispatched**
- Further report linked to the previous report (fight) - **Male has been ARRESTED**
- Report over a male following Reporting persons child and friend—**PCSO to call round for reassurance and updates**
- Report regarding youths trying to gain access to the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING—**Response officers dispatched—search made no trace. Officers spoke to a number of youths in surrounding area who stated that teenagers were hanging around the area but left.**
- Report in regards to a vulnerable male walking out of school and walking along bypass—**RESPONSE officers dispatched—male returned back to school and spoken to in regards to his safety**
- Concern over an ex partner due to the messages that they are sending reporting person—**RESPONSE officers dispatched to the person who has sent messages. There is no cause for concern they were just sent in anger.**
- Report in regards to ongoing neighbour issue which PCSO ROBERTSON / PC LOCK have been dealing with—**PCSO ROBERTSON is in talks with WEAVER VALE in regards to this and MEDICATION for both parties has been offered to try and resolve issue , as there is no illegal / criminal issues that there is evidence off.**
- Report of youths gaining access to LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING as reporting person has been sent images of youths in the building , but can not confirm wether this is LIVE or not—**Information has been placed through as INTEL**
- Report of youths causing issues for reporting person—**RESPONSE officers dispatched and spoken to youths , due to one youths attitude towards issue and officer , they were ARRESTED**
- Second report regarding youths causing issues on CLIFTON DRIVE—**PCSO from NORTHWICH attended scene and spoke to youths and reporting person , youths moved on**

LEFTWICH (cont)

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN (cont)

- Third report regarding youths on CLIFTON DRIVE , stating that they are drunk and shouting abuse— **RESPONSE officers dispatched , youths spoken to and they were friendly and helpful just hanging out , no cause for concern**
- Further report in regards to youths causing issue on CLIFTON DRIVE—**RESPONSE officers attended and spoken to youths and moved on**
- Further report in regards to males on CLIFTON DRIVE trying to smash windows—**RESPONSE officers attended and conducted stop searches on all present with that details of all obtained.**
- Report of a motorbike user pulling up and being aggressive whilst reporting person is picking up daughter – **reporting person just wants the issue logged**
- Further report in regards to youths causing issues on CLIFTON DRIVE—**RESPONSE dispatched and youths spoken to and words of advice given. Issue is that they are not doing anything wrong except for just being in the area.**
- Another report in regards to youths climbing drainpipe and banging on window and causing damage—**RESPONSE officers reattended area , search made and 3 youths stop search and details obtained , no evidence suggests that these youths caused the damage.**
- Further report in regards to youths causing issues on CLIFTON DRIVE by playing music loud— **RESPONSE officers attended and spoke to the youths , who were just sat talking to each other**
- Another incident involved youths climbing up drain pipe to bang and damage window on CLIFTON DRIVE—**RESPONSE officers attended , youths in area stop searched and spoken to no evidence to provide they were causing any damage**
- 2nd report in regards to youths climbing up drain pipe— **RESPONSE officers dealt with this at same time as previous report**
- Another report in regards to youths causing damage by kicking security gate on CLIFTON DRIVE—**RESPONSE officer spotted youths in area and knew who they were and advised to leave the area ,no signs of damage**
- Report requesting for police to attend address due to the fact that two people were going to attend the address and cause trouble—**SAFEGUARDING advice given**
- Report from safe guard lead from school in regards to concern over a student who is afraid to go home due a possible XL bully being at the address— **PC ASHTON (Whitton and Rudheath) attended address numerous occasions along with PCSO ROBERTSON. No cause for alarm with dog. Safeguard lead advised as well**
- Report of a youth pushing over reporting persons father—**RESPONSE officers have attended and spoke to victim who states that he approached the youth and that's why the youth pushed him. Victim does not want to make a complaint**
- 1 more report in regards to the youth pushing over the family member—**RESPONSE dealt with both reports at the same time**
- Further report in regards to youths causing issues on CLIFTON DRIVE—**RESPONSE officers dispatched and spoken to youths who left the area**
- Report in regards to a female being pushed—**PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance and more information / CCTV**
- Further report in regards to youths throwing stones at window on CLIFTON DRIVE— **PCSO ROBERTSON to contact Reporting Person as incident occurred early evening, to see if CCTV is available or to identify the youths**
- Concern over a building left unsecure—**RESPONSE officers dispatched and the building was secure**
- Report over concern that reporting persons child is setting fires in another persons back garden and there is no adults present—**RESPONSE officers dispatched and spoke to mother of child who was at the address. No cause for concern as there is a firepit which is lit when parents are present**
- Report in regards to a suspicious vehicle that is parked outside callers address.—**PCSO ROBERTSON to call round for reassurance**

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

- Report of youths starting a fire in the wooded area—**Fire attended**
- Report of car window being smashed—**Crimed and awaiting CCTV**
- Report of back window of car being smashed—**crimed**
- Report of damage to van—**crimed**
- Report of an item being thrown at an outhouse and has cracked the window—**Crimed and PCSO to call for reassurance**

THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE

- Report of car being broken into, but nothing taken —**Crimed**

KINGSMEAD

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report over concern in relation to a family member who is out of control—**RESPONSE officers dispatched but there is nothing officers can address as it may be alcohol related , expect for ensuring they are safe. AMBULANCE also dispatched**
- Report of two males looking around cars and trying doors— **RESPONSE officers dispatched , search made no trace—PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance and to see if CCTV is available**
- Report due to a male shouting “HELP ME” - **RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched—search made no trace for the male**
- Report in regards to possible harassment from neighbour due to a parking dispute—**Safeguarding advice given and PCSO ROBERTSON has been made aware of the issue and is dealing with the issue**
- Report of a dog bite whilst postman was delivering mail—**PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**

DAVENHAM

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of some suspicious activity when a male passed a female a package and then ran off—**has been placed through as INTEL and PCSO ROBERTSON to call for further information and reassurance**
- Report of a group of youths walking down the middle of the road near RIVERSIDE ORGANIC—**RESPONSE dispatched , search made no trace of youths**
- Report of a DRONE flying low around reporting persons property and has crashed onto the roof—**PCSO ROBERTSON dispatched and seized the DRONE , safeguarding advice given and INTEL placed in due to what reporting person stated. Reporting person understands it is unlikely that we would get ID of the owner.**
- Report over concern in regards to neighbour as Reporting person has not seen them for a couple of days, Reporting person does not want police , but will update if there is any updates.—**PCSO To call round for updates**
- Report of a neighbour being threatening and holding a hammer to reporting persons face— **RESPONSE of-ficers dispatched and female arrested**
- Report of dog on dog attack and owner of the dog that attacked shouting abuse—**PCSO ROBERTSON t call for reassurance , issue resolved by all parties involved**

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Report of a neighbour parking over reporting persons driveway —**Reporting person is happy for this to be dealt with by PCSO ROBERTSON—no obstructions caused**

THEFT

- Report of Iphone being taken—**CRIMED**

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

- Report of damaged being caused to vehicle —**CRIMED**

MOULTON

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report of an ongoing neighbour issue—**PCSO ROBERTSON is aware of this and is dealing with this. Has contacted reporting person and just arranging a suitable time to attend address**
- Report over concern for safety as Reporting Person received a message from friend that she intended to harm herself - **RESPONSE officers dispatched and spoke to the person who sent the message**
- Report in regards to an telephone scam in which reporting person received a txt asking for money—**Information received has been placed through as INTEL—PCSO ROBERTSON to offer reassurance**
- Report of threats and abusive from a neighbour and this is an ongoing issue which housing and police are aware of—**Reporting person does not want officers attending as housing are dealing with , housing have got in touch with PCSO ROBERTSON in regards to this as Reporting person states police are aware , PCSO ROBERTSON is unaware of this issue.**
- Concern over a female who states that she is planning to end her life—**Female located by RESPONSE officers**
- Report in regards to threatening messages being sent on FACEBOOK—**RESPONSE officers are being assigned this issue. PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**
- Report of a female screaming and shouting—**RESPONSE dispatched and search made no trace of any female in area**
- Report in regards with issues with child not attending school and going to another address - **Further call from reporting person to state that they are attending family friends address to get their child—PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**

THEFT

- Report of bike being taken from MOULTON PARK—**Crimed and CCTV has been requested for the incident**

BOSTOCK

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Report over issues relating to neighbours shouting abused and threats—**RESPONSE officer spoke to reporting person over phone and safeguarding advice given. PCSO ROBERTSON has been notified of the issue**

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Report of COWS obstructing road—**RESPONSE dispatched and area was made secure**
- Report of debris in road—**RESPONSE dispatched and area searched no obstructions in road**
- Report of a tree down and blocking road—**HIGHWAYS notified**

LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING MADE MORE SECURE

With our continued working partnerships with NORTHWICH COUNCIL and CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER COUNCIL there has been some considerable updates to the issues that were occurring due to the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING.

House to house was completed by PCSO ROBERTSON who notified all residents within the surrounding location of the issues that were being reporting , their feedback and the updates that was happening to the building.

To make the building more secure fencing has been placed all around the perimeter to make it more difficult for anyone to gain access to the building (for their safety, due to the building now being dangerous to enter). This fencing has been covered in ANTI-VANDAL PAINT so that anyone climbing the fence would ruin their clothing and stain their skin.

The building is now on the market for sale and once the building / land have been sold , then their will be more permanent fixtures in place to make the building safe and secure.



HALLOWEEN IS COMING

OP TREACLE our yearly police operation is nearly upon us again. In which we will work with members of the community , businesses and partner agencies to reduce the amount of ASB over the Halloween and Bonfire Night periods.

POSTERS that help make HALLOWEEN a more comfortable experience (notifying members of the community if trick or treating is allowed at their property) are now available to download from the CHESHIRE POLICE WEBSITE , or can be collected from businesses from around the community from 10th October

Below is a list of priorities residents have made us aware of, which are on the patrol plan. Updates will be in future newsletters and on Facebook.



WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

- More Patrols in area as there is ASB issues
- Safeguarding people from social media bullying—**Safe guarding advice has been provided on our Social Media Channels and to people who bring it to our attention**

LEFTWICH

- Speed Monitoring on CLIFTON DRIVE / DUNHAM ROAD / LONDON ROAD (30MPH SECTION) and LIME AVE
- More Visibility around WOODPECKER DRIVE area / GRANVILLE ROAD area
- Extend the school parking patrols to WOODSIDE TERRACE area— **is now included in the school parking patrols**
- Issues with OFF ROAD BIKES— **Owner of the BIKE has been spoken to and warned if witnessed again, bike may be seized**
- More PATROLS around the play parks due to ASB— **latest incident being looked into 3 female youths have been identified and house visits will be conducted.**
- More patrols around the shops due to ASB issues - **CLIFTON DRIVE IS NOW CLASSED AS A HOTSPOT DUE TO ISSUES THAT HAVE BEEN REPORTED AND PATROLS ARE NOW IN PLACE WITH YOUTHS BEING ASKED TO MOVE ON**
- Leftwich building needs to be patrolled more (NEW)—**We have worked with our partner agencies to ensure building is more secure and patrols will continue**
- Provide something for the youths to be involved in (NEW)—**this is being looked into as we use to have a YOUTH CLUB operating in MOULTON but we just need a building to hold something and put something on**

KINGSMEAD

- Parking patrols on REGENCY WAY just after the ROUNDABOUT— **Parking patrols have been conducted by MINI POLICE**
- Speed Monitoring on REGENCY WAY and DUKES WAY—**Will be included in the MINI POLICE PROGRAM**
- School Parking patrols extend to MONARCH DRIVE—**Now included in the school parking patrol**
- More Patrols around REGENCY WAY RETAIL PARK
- Littering from the students that attend SIR JOHN DEANES—**this will be looked into by the MINI POLICE**
- Anti Social Behaviour issues around the community—**THERE HAS BEEN SOME ISSUES WITH ASB WHICH ARE BEING LOOKED INTO DUE TO IT BEING REPORTED TO 101**
- Parking patrols around WYNDHAM CLOSE— **Parking patrols are taking place**
- Parking near KING EDWARDS CLOSE (NEW)—**Parking patrols are now taking place**

DAVENHAM

- Speed Monitoring on MOUNT PLEASANT / FOUNTAIN LANE / LONDON ROAD (20 MPH SECTION) / HARTFORD ROAD) and CHURCH ROAD at commuter times
- Provide events / things to do for the youths in the community—**Football sessions have been set up in AUGUST**
- More Parking patrols around the area
- Issues with OFF ROAD BIKES / ELECTRIC SCOOTERS around JACK LANE—**One electric scooter has been seized with the community**
- Parking issues around THE PAVILLIONS junction of HARTFORD ROAD / EATON LANE—**FIXED PENALTY TICKETS have been issued to those vehicles that cause issues**
- Bring up issues relating to CANNANBIS to WEAVER VALE—**Are in touch with WEAVER VALE and will raise this up again**
- Parking Issues at the top of CHURCH ROAD / junction of LONDON ROAD—**Vehicles that have been witnessed causing issues (which mainly are linked to parking on double yellow lines to attend the pharmacy) will be issued FIXED PENALTY TICKETS**
- Parking on LONDON ROAD and LABURNUM ROAD—**Any issues witnessed on LONDON ROAD will be issued with FIXED PENALTY TICKETS as it's the main road PCSO ROBERTSON uses to get to MOULTON. So LONDON ROAD is being patrolled. LABURNUM ROAD is a private road so parking can not be addressed.**

- ASB in the MERE BANK AREA— **No issues reported to 101**


MOULTON

- Speed Monitoring on MAIN ROAD / WHITLOW LANE
- Speed Gun Sessions not just JACK LANE
- More Rural crime involvement especially with the Badger sets
- Parking Patrols around YARDLEY AVE—**No parking issues reported to PCSO ROBERTSON**
- More Visibility around the YARDLEY AVE / RAVENSCROFT areas
- Parking Patrols Around the RAVENSCROFT / WEAVER ROAD - **No Parking issues reported to PCSO ROBERTSON**
- Issues with OFF ROAD BIKES / ELECTRIC SCOOTERS around JACK LANE—**One electric scooter has been seized within the area**

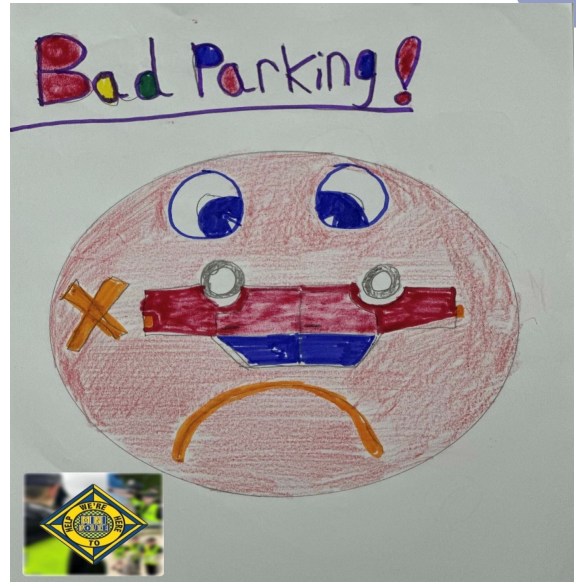

 - 1 parking in a resident only area



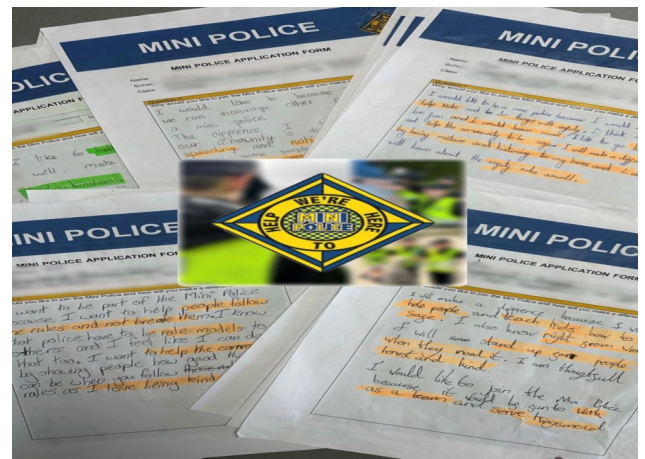


THE MINI POLICE—SEPTEMBER

KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE RECRUITMENT

The current MINI POLICE are now in YEAR 6 which is an important year due to their SATs. They would like to stay on as MINI POLICE but unfortunately their SATS are more important. With that we are now recruiting for our new officers to come and join the KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE.

A presentation has been conducted by PCSO ROBERTSON explaining the MINI POLICE and the PROGRAMME, and anyone that was interested in joining the MINI POLICE took an application form to complete with a 2 week deadline.



The completed application forms have been collected by PCSO ROBERTSON and those who were successful in the application stage are being invited to a 3 to 1 INTERVIEW that will take place at the school

MINI POLICE IS COMING TO DAVENHAM

Due to the great work and positive feedback that the KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE were achieving , DAVENHAM PARISH COUNCIL together with DAVENHAM PRIMARY asked for the MINI POLICE to be brought in the community.

After having meetings with the parish council and school we are pleased to announce that the MINI POLICE PROGRAMME will be coming to DAVENHAM.

Just like KINGSMEAD , there will be presentation that would be given to the children of YEAR 5 (which has been completed) with application forms handed out to all those who are interested (with a deadline of 08/10/24). Then those who have passed the interview stage will then be invited to a 3 on 1 interview (TBD).

The MINI POLICE will run alongside KINGSMEAD and will look at areas in which they can help and improve in DAVENHAM. The first issue would be school parking. So parents beware , the MINI POLICE are coming ..
