ROGUE TRADERS AFFECT THE COMMUNITY

We have been alerted to two males knocking on peoples doors in MOULTON enquiring about if there are any roofing jobs that can be done for the resident. Whilst one male knocks on the door another male is already half way up ladders that have been placed when the resident answers the door , therefore putting pressure onto the resident. The pressure increases when the males state that there is an issue and quote one price and then reduce the cost. But then find another issue which then increases the price.

IF YOU AGREE TO A PRICE, AND ACCEPT WORK BEING DONE , THIS THEN BECOMES A CIVIL MATTER IF SOMETHING GOES WRONG

We have had one issue where the resident stated that they did not have the cash on hand for a certain job, to which the males would offer to take the resident to the BANK.

OFFERING TO TAKE YOU TO THE BANK IS A HUGE RED FLAG

Please keep yourself and others safe from this.

- if you need work doing to your property , DO NOT accept business from someone knocking on your door. Instead you seek a reliable business / professional
- DO NOT hand money over until work has been completed
- NEVER EVER feel pressured to hand money over.
- ENSURE a contract is issued which states, the work that is being done and the cost to you. A reliable business / professional will provide a contract to be signed.

DON'T be rushed into making a decision

DON'T pay cash as its not traceable

FIRE AT THE LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING

Over the past few months , PCSO ROBERTSON has been working with representatives from CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER COUNCIL and NORTHWICH TOWN COUNCIL in making the building safe and secure.

Since 2022 there has been issues of ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR with number of youths gaining access to the building and then smashing and destroying items that are within the building. Reports have been made to 101 in regards to this and officers including PCSO ROBERTSON / PC LOCK and RESPONSE OFFICERS conducting patrols around the building, analysing where there are entry points. Conducting patrols within the building and speaking to anyone that is around or inside the building.

Every time there was a patrol conducted and there was a clear entry point this was boarded up.

In August 2023 after numerous entry points boarded up (due to boards being taken down / off) a joint meeting took place with PCSO ROBERTSON and council members in which it was agreed that fencing would be put around the building with ANTI VANDAL PAINT therefore hopefully stopping youths getting access to the building.

Reports to 101 decreased once the fencing went up but unfortunately started slowly coming back in, in the middle of November. Once again patrols were put on and entry points accessed.

However at the end of November there was one report, which stated that there was a number of youths inside the building in which officers from Northwich North were dispatched . However the report also stated that the youths had left the area. The officers accessed the fencing , which noticed there was access through the fence , but no clear entry into the building. Which was notified to PCSO ROBERTSON who was on days off.

The next day PCSO ROBERTSON received the information , but however that day the building was on fire. Emergency services were called with 4 fire engines from surrounding areas together with officers. Roads were closed so that the emergency services could get access to the building and put out the fire. Due to structure damage to the roof, that the fire caused, this had to be made safe, which delayed the roads being opened up again.

PCSO ROBERTSON together with PC BAXTER (Hartford and Greenbank) will be investigating what happened on that day together with the report the previous night and information we have received in regards youths running away from the area.

With the building itself CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER are still planning to sell the building, which was in its final stages before the fire



WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report in regards to suspicious behaviour from neighbour due to pouring diesel into his vehicle—**PCSO ROBERTSON is aware of this and has been in touch with WEAVER VALE due to place that the fuel is being stored.**

Second report in regards to the male pouring diesel into vehicle—**logged as intel**

Third report in regards to the male pouring diesel into his vehicle—**PCSO ROBERTSON has spoke to the reporting person asking what makes the male suspicious, and obtained further details. Has advised WEAVER VALE is looking into this, due to the storage of the fuel.**

Report in regards to a DRONE flying over the area—**logged in as INTEL**

Report in regards to a threatening letter being received by reporting person—**When questioned for more information over this letter by call handler , reporting person refused to give more details**

THEFT

Report in regards to barrels of COOKING OIL being taken from the BOWLING GREEN INN—**crimed and CCTV is being obtained**

HIGHWAY DISRUPTION

Report of vehicle parking on the footpath and completely obstructing it by VERDIN HOUSE—**PCSO ROBERTSON has contacted reported person, obtained more details and stated patrols will occur around the area and if there is a issue witnessed then it will be looked into**

LEFTWICH

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

Report over scaffolding being taken down and its owned by the reporting person—**Civil matter due to building work**

Report in regards to a male being aggressive and knocked on numerous doors at the PREMIER INN—**RESPONSE DISPATCHED but further call to state that male has been kicked out of the hotel and has got a taxi, so has left the area**

Report in regards to child safety, due to constant screaming—**RESPONSE OFFICERS have been dispatched and spoke to all involved—No issues with child concern as the children are loud and there is a lot living in a small space**

Report into a person throwing garden waster over fence and leave dog poo by front door—**PCSO ROBERTSON has tried to contact reporting person, but no success**

Report in regards to reporting person having a drink thrown over her and being called a grass—**PCSO ROBERTSON is looking into this as is aware of all parties concerned. WEAVER VALE have been notified as they are weaver vale tenants**

Report in regards to a male knocking on door and asking for a USB cable—**PCSO ROBERTSON spoke to reporting person , no further issues as the male had the wrong address**

Report in regards to a firework being thrown from a specific address window — **no evidence to state that it came from a certain address as the reporting person was driving when firework landed onto the ground. RESPONSE OFFICERS were dispatched and went to the address that was identified but no one was in.**

Report of a male parking behind shops on CLIFTON DRIVE and using a drone—**PCSO ROBERTSON has attended the address and spoke to reporting person—There has been no issues since report and advised to contact 101 if further issues or contact PCSO ROBERTSON if have any information linked to it.**

Report in regards to YOUTHS shouting abuse at the reporting person whilst attending the shops on CLIFTON DRIVE —**PCSO ROBERTSON has spoken to the Reporting person. No further issues since and Reporting person states that there has never been an issue before with them. No description / CCTV and unknown who these youths are.**

Report in regards to TWO MALES on a bike all in black riding around dangerously— **Logged in as INTEL**

Report in regards to threats being received by reporting person from partners ex—**RESPONSE OFFICERS looking into this**

LEFTWICH

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN—continued

Report in regards to YOUTHS possibly inside the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING and being chased out by reporting person—**PCSOs from NORTHWICH NORTH attended and patrolled the area. There was no one present , PCSO's gained access through the fence but could not get inside the building. Will make PCSO ROBERTSON aware of the issue.**

Report in regards to two males running away from the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING which is on FIRE—**logged for INTEL—PCSO ROBERTSON has contacted reporting person to see if he may know who this male may be**

HIGHWAY DISRUPTION

Report of vehicle parking too close to the junction of PRIORY AVE—**PCSO ROBERTSON is aware of this and has checked the issue—vehicle was a little too close and therefore given an advisory ticket**

KINGSMEAD

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report in regards to a student possibly having a knife in SIR JOHN DEANES COLLEGE—**PC COLLICT and PCSO ROBERTSON attended the college and with help from staff the suspected student was spoken to and searched. There was NO KNIFE and there has been no further issues.**

Report in regards to a suspicious vehicle breaking down in front of REPORTING PERSONS home—**PCSO ROBERTSON has contacted reporting person. The vehicle was moved onto the layby by ST GEORGES WAY PARK to cause no obstruction and there was concern over the female. The Vehicle has now been moved**

THEFT

Report of bags being taken , possibly by neighbour whilst reporting person was moving out—**CRIMED**

Report over a key to a vehicle being taken by two people who came to look at the car—**Officers have spoke to all parties as issue relates to reporting person selling a car and interested parties test driving the car and then trying to negotiate the price. As all parties couldn't agree on price , the buyers left. No evidence states that they had a key , as seller still had the master key**

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report of three females knocking on reporting persons door and lying on FRONT GARDEN, and when door was answered , the three females started to record them—**PCSO ROBERTSON has called for reassurance , there has been no further issues and females not known and no CCTV**

Report of a male in silver vehicle using torch on HARTFORD ROAD, looking at addresses—**Further call to stated that this was the milkman, PCSO ROBERTSON has called for further reassurance.**

Report into possible fraud as item that was purchased off the internet has not been delivered—**Advice given to call the online store and to contact bank.**

Report of a MALE walking on the footpath , looking under the influence—**No officers to deploy**

Second report of the MALE walking down road , this time with blood on him—**RESPONSE OFFICERS delayed—search of area made—no trace of male**

Report of a apple core being thrown at REPORTING PERSON from a passing car , whilst out on a walk—**Reporting person has provided half of the details of the car—PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**

Report of YOUTHS causing issues outside of the PREMIER SHOP which lead to a bottle of cider being taken—**PCSO ROBERTSON to call and see if there is CCTV of the youths to see if they can be recognised.**

Report of sheep in the road of WHATCROFT HALL LANE—**Due to FIRE no officers to dispatch**

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report from a parent over daughter , that she will not leave her friend alone— **No crimes reported**

Report in regards to a BUILDER knocking on reporting persons GRANDFATHERS door and speaking about the roof , quoting one price and then changing price from £3'000 to £12'000. When the grandfather stated he didn't have that money , the builder stated that he would drive him to the bank. When that didn't happen , the victim requested for the roof to be placed back how it was , in which a quote of £5'000 was given.—**ROGUE TRADER—victim has been provided safeguarding advice and advice to contact TRADING STANDARDS. PCSO ROBERTSON has contacted grand daughter to speak about this. SOCIAL MEDIA posts have been posted.**

Report over suspicious behaviour as male is parked outside of MORRISONS and is filmed and recording the shop and what is behind the counter—**PCSO ROBERTSON has called into MORRISONS and has notified shop supervisor to pass the message on about any suspicious behaviour—no further issues.**

Report in regards to a DRONE being flown over the PRIMARY SCHOOL—**Logged for intel**

Report in regards to a MALE shouting and threatening someone—**may be a medical issue as the Reporting person is bed bound and has a medical history. Family members were contacted—no further issues**

Report over concern for child's safety as Male is always heard screaming and shouting when alone with child—**RESPONSE OFFICERS attended—Male was helpful and explained that the issue could be when he's playing on his XBOX with headset on. Spoke to partner and states the same. Home checked out and child is well and looked after. No cause for concern**

Report over concern for a resident of the CARAVAN PARK due to messages being sent to SOLICITOR as there is a dispute ongoing.—**Safeguarding advice given if there is further issues after this to contact AMBULANCE**

Report of two males trying to break into one of the outhouses that belongs to MOULTON SCHOOL—**males have left the area whilst on call. School have been made aware. PCSO ROBERTSON to call for reassurance**

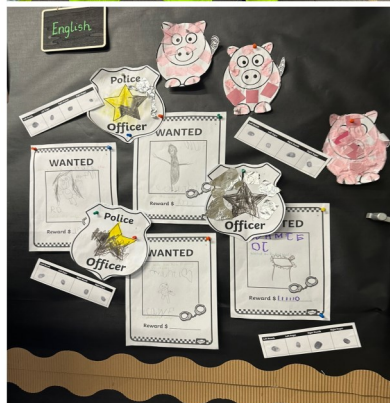


OFFICERS ATTEND REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY

The KINGSMEAD attestation will be on 3rd December with the DAVENHAM attestation planned for early January
