KEYLESS CAR THEFTS

Over the past few months there has been a number of VEHICLE CAR THEFTS that have all involved KEYLESS CARS. These vehicles have been all been taken over night whilst the victims are asleep.

These thefts have not just happened within our area but also neighbouring communities including HARTFORD and have reached other areas such as CREWE.

WHAT ARE CLASSED AS KEYLESS CARS ?

Cars with keyless entry unlock automatically when the key comes within a short distance of the car. This can be from inside a pocket or bag. If you have to push a button on your car key to open your car, you don't have keyless entry.

HOW DO THEY GET THE CAR ?

Keyless car theft or 'relay theft' is when a device is used to fool the car into thinking the key is close by. This unlocks the car and starts the ignition.

Thieves only need to be within a few metres of your car key to capture the signal, even if it's inside your home. This means that even if your car and home are secure, thieves can still unlock, start and steal your car.

HOW TO KEEP YOURSELF SAFE WITH KEYLESS CARS

For all KEYLESS CAR OWNERS we advise the following :

- When at home keep your car key (and the spare) well away from the car.
- Don't leave keys near the front door or hallway
- Put the keys in a screened or signal-blocking pouch, such as a FARADAY BAG and check if the bag or pouch is still working every few months.
- Reprogramme your keys if you buy a second hand car.
- Turn off wireless signals on your fob when it's not being used.
- If possible keep your keys in a FARADAY BOX



PLEASE REPORT SUSPICIOUS BEHAVIOUR TO US

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report of youths riding bikes on footpath dangerously wearing LEFTWICH HIGH UNIFORM—PCSO LEE conducted reassurance visit and obtained a name of the person who this may be. Spoke to school and there was no one at LEFTWICH HIGH SCHOOL with that name. PCSO LEE has spoke to school in regards youths using bikes

Report over concern for a friend after receiving messages that they were going to hurt themselves.—Further call from reporting person to say that they have attended address and spoke to their friend , there has been a few issues but reporting person does not want to involve the police

LEFTWICH

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

Report in regards to a MALE riding a bike at high speed and dangerously on CLIFTON DRIVE— RESPONSE dispatched search made no trace

Second Report in regards to a MALE riding a bike dangerously—No Patrols in area, PCSO LEE has been alerted to this issue

Further report (on separate day) in regards the MALE on bike—PCSO LEE is looking not on duty to look into this , as issue is being passed to NEIGHBOURHOOD POLICE

Report in regards to reporting persons SON not going with AMBULANCE as they have been called to an incident and son is needed to go with them—RESPONSE dispatched and male went with AMBULANCE

Report from LEFTWICH HIGH SCHOOL in regards to a young male not going home , which is part an ongoing issue in MOULTON—RESPONSE dispatched and young male is safe and well at home

Report in regards to a group of YOUTHS causing issues on CLIFTON DRIVE—RESPONSE dispatched , search of area, no youths present. PCSO LEE called to speak to reporting person , but no response

Further report in regards to a MALE riding dangerously on a MOTORBIKE—PCSO LEE was aware of issue and in area when report came in. MOTORBIKE witness and details obtained and location of the owner located. Further issues with this will result in BIKE being seized

Report in regards to a FEMALE screaming on LONDON ROAD—No further reports , PCSO spoke to reporting person and there has been no further issues or sightings

Another incident in which MALE YOUTH would not leave school to go home—NEIGHBOURHOOD POLICE are aware of this issue. RESPONSE attended and male youth back at home.

Report in regards to TWO MALES fighting inside a location—RESPONSE dispatched , MALE **ARRESTED**.

Report of a suspicious vehicle parking up and taking pictures of another vehicle on neighbours drive—PCSO LEE has attended reporting persons address and no response. No further reports , logged in as INTEL

Report over concern for a MALE staying at the WOODPECKER PREMIER INN—Safeguarding advice given and advised to contact SOCIAL SERVICES

Further call in regards to male who is staying at the WOODPECKER PREMIER INN—Advised to contact AMBULANCE

Report in regards to threatening messages being sent from someone wo reporting person knows but has on going issue in relation to them and requested for them NOT to contact them—RESPONSE attended and is looking into this

Report in regards to threatening messages being sent to reporting person—RESPONSE have spoken to reporting person and safeguarding advice given. PCSO LEE to call fro reassurance

Report of a MALE in neighbours garden , damaging fence and vehicles—RESPONSE dispatched and MALE **ARRESTED**

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report over concern for a tenant , as the reporting person is the LANDLORD and has not had an contact from their tenant for a month—**No dispatch as not a police issue**

Report in regards to tenants of the apartments above TESCO causing issues—**PCSO ROBERTSON is looking into this and is trying to get in touch with the tenants**

Report in regards to reporting person receiving THREATENING MESSAGES from ex partner which is in relation to ongoing issues— **RESPONSE dispatched and issue has been pass out of force**

Report in regards to group of youths on QUEENS HILL sliding down hill and destroying plants that have been planted there—**RESPONSE dispatched due to being near A533. Search Made no Trace**

Second report in regards to large group of YOUTHS on QUEENS HILL—**RESPONSE has already patrolled area , no youths in sight**

Report from AMBULANCE due to a MALE having a MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS and threatening those present—**REPNONSE dispatched and spoke to all parties present and there was no threatening behavior—no cause for concern**

Report in regards to YOUTHS being in the DAVENHAM DAY CARE CENTRE location—**PCSO LEE dispatched and area searched—no youths present. CWAC have been contacted in regards to making area secure**

Report in regards to an EVRI driver being abusive and threatening—**SAFEGUARDING advice given and PCSO LEE to contact reporting person for reassurance**

Report of green lasers being shined into reporting persons address— **has been passed to PCSO LEE to conduct home reassurance visit**

Second report of GREEN LASERS being shined into the reporting persons address—**PCSO LEE has tried to contact reporting person but no response**

Report in regards to tapebeing TAPED ONTO RING DOOR CAMERA in the same area as the stolen vehicle—**PCSO LEE spoke to reporting person whilst doing house to house enquires**

Report of a suspicious vehcile in the same area that stolen vehicle was taken—**has been logged in as INTEL**

Report of a suspicious WHITE VAN in the area of the stolen vehicle—**logged in as INTEL , however PCSO LEE has found out they are GUTTER CLEANING BUSINESS and is working on certain homes in area .**

Report of youths playing football on the REGENCY RETAIL PARK and breaking a shop sign—**PCSO LEE and PC BOX has attended and has obtained a name of a possible suspect and will conduct a home visit.**

Report of a large group of youths on the REGENCY WAY RETAIL PARK causing a disturbance and trying to set the fences of KINGSMEAD PRIMARY SCHOOL on fire—**RESPONSE attended and youths moved on—only one name was obtained by RESPONSE , therefore PCSO LEE is requesting CCTV to identify all those involved**

Report of a suspicious Van taking a pallet of bricks—**Logged in as INTEL and there was no further reports of a theft**

Report of two suspicious vehicles by the play area on DUKES WAY—**PCSO LEE and PC BOX in area and dispatched , search made no trace**

HIGHWAY DISRUPTION

Report of issues around the KINGSMEAD PRIMARY SCHOOL area of parents double parking—**PCSO LEE is patrolling the area , no is finding no issues when in area. Which parents are stating is due to him being in area. Patrols will continue. MINI POLICE will be starting their PARKING PATROLS in MARCH**

FRAUD

Report in regards to emails and accounts being hacked into and orders from America being authorized—**SAFEGUARDING advice given and PCSO LEE conducted reassurance visit.**

THEFT OF A MOTOR VEHICLE

Report of a vehicle being taken overnight— **CRIMED and PCSO LEE along with INVESTIGAGTION team conducting HOUSE to HOUSE to obtain CCTV and information.**

Report of reporting persons DAUGHTER not going inside the home , staying outside due to ongoing issue—**passed onto our partner agencies as they are aware**

Report of a suspicious vehicle in the area of PROSPECT DRIVE—**has been logged in as INTEL**

THEFT

Report of a male going into a neighbours back garden and taking items from a skip—**CRIMED and no report from the actual person who had the skip in garden of things being taken. PCSO LEE conducted reassurance visit and obtained details of vehicle the male was in and submitted all information as INTEL**

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Report of a YOUTHS throwing and damaging cones that have been put out by REPORTING PERSON—**PCSO LEE has attended address and CCTV has been obtained and is seeking identity of the youths involved.**

MOULTON

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report in regards to threatening behaviour from a MALE after there was an incident between REPORTING PERSONS dog (as they were walking the dog off lead) and the MALES dog—**REPORTING PERSON states that she did NOT want to speak to officer just to log the incident.**

Report in regards to a YOUNG MALE not going home, and is outside reporting persons home and is part of an ongoing issue—**RESPONSE dispatched and young male returned home—PCSO LEE is aware of the issue and will conduct a home visit with PC BOX to speak to the young male**

Report in regards to a SUSPICIOUS VEHICLE which is parked outside reporting persons home and is acting strangely, as its reverse and three point turning when it's a loop road—**logged in as INTEL and PCSO LEE conducted reassurance visit , no further reports**

Report in regards to possible HARRASSMENT—**PCSO LEE and RESPONSE attended—is an ongoing issue which is being looked into**

Further report in regards to MALE YOUTH and home issues— **RESPONSE OFFICERS attended and spoke to MOTHER and issues related to MALE YOUTH being excluded from school, NEIGHBOURHOOD TEAM are aware of the issue**

Report in regards to a MALE jumping out of a vehicle and attacking the reporting person—**RESPONSE dispatched and MALE **ARRESTED****

Report of online accounts being hacked—**SAFEGUARDING advice given**

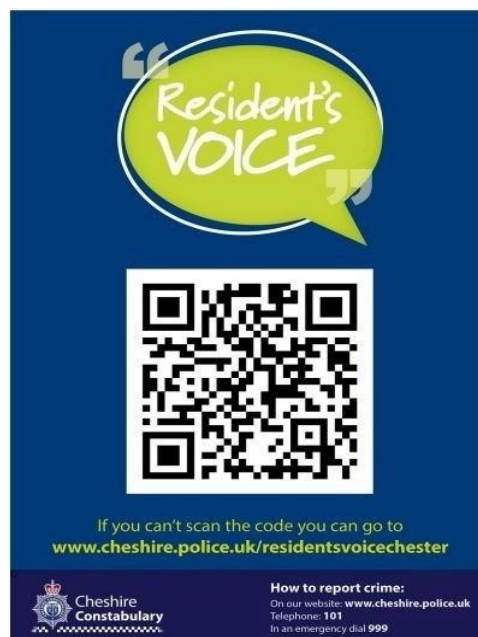

- More Patrols in area as there is ASB issues (**No Reports of ASB within the area—2nd month running**)
- **NEW (FEB) - Speeding on LONDON ROAD—Speeding will be looked into after EASTER**

Below is a list of priorities residents have made us aware of , which are on the patrol plan. Updates will be in future newsletters and on Facebook.



LEFTWICH

- Speed Monitoring on CLIFTON DRIVE / DUNHAM ROAD / LONDON ROAD (30MPH SECTION) and LIME AVE—**Speed Camera Sessions will be up and running soon**
- More Visibility around WOODPECKER DRIVE area / GRANVILLE ROAD area
- **NEW (FEB) Extend the school parking patrols to WOODSIDE TERRACE area— is now included in the school parking patrols**
- More patrols around the shops due to ASB issues - **CLIFTON DRIVE IS NOW CLASSED AS A HOTSPOT DUE TO ISSUES THAT HAVE BEEN REPORTED AND PATROLS ARE NOW IN PLACE WITH YOUTHS BEING ASKED TO MOVE ON**
- Provide something for the youths to be involved in —**this is being looked into as we use to have a YOUTH CLUB operating in MOULTON but we just need a building to hold something and put something on**
- **NEW (JAN) —We need more visibility especially around CLIFTON DRIVE— PATROLS are occurring when PCSO ROBERTSON is on duty. POLICE SURGERIES will now take place in HOT SPOTS and CLIFTON DRIVE will be one of the new locations that will start middle of FEB**
- **NEW (JAN) - Drug dealers and Drug Use—We actively seeking INTEL / INFORMATION in regards to this and actively work with the community / partner agencies to deal with this. And any good results are always posted on our social media channels. PCSO ROBERTSON has actively been involved with 2 operations with one person being evicted from property and another arrested.**
- **NEW (FEB) - There should be a ONE WAY SYSTEM around the SCHOOL PICKUP area—Will pass these concerns to RACHEL WATERMAN who is the CWAC representative for LEFTWICH**
- **(NEW) FEB—Speeding on DUNHAM ROAD— Speeding will be looked into just like parking , this will happen after EASTER**
- **(NEW) FEB—School parking around LEFTWICH PRIMARY and HIGH is becoming an issue again— School parking patrols are occurring and any issued witnessed have been addressed and updates are placed weekly on our social media channels**
- **NEW) FEB—Parking on DUNHAM ROAD—is now placed on PATROL PLAN**
- **(NEW) FEB—Parkin on ELLESMERE ROAD—is now placed on PATROL PLAN— Vehicles already been issued ADVISORIES**

- School Parking patrols extend to MONARCH DRIVE – Now included in the school parking patrol
- More Patrols around REGENCY WAY RETAIL PARK
- Littering from the students that attend SIR JOHN DEANES – this will be looked into by the MINI POLICE
- Anti Social Behaviour issues around the community – No issues reported since OCTOBER
- Parking patrols around WYNDHAM CLOSE – Parking patrols are taking place
- Parking near KING EDWARDS CLOSE – Parking patrols are now taking place – one resident has been spoken to in regards to parking
- (OCT) PARKING ON DROPPED KERBS around the BICKLEY CLOSE area – Parking patrols now in place
- (DEC) Parking on DRIVEWAYS , people should park on their driveways and not on the road – PCSO Robertson will look into this in the next few weeks to see if there are obstructions caused
- **NEW – (JAN) - More parking patrols especially around RESIDENTIAL AREAS – PCSO ROBERTSON is doing parking patrols in areas that have been notified to himself via 101 and RESIDENTS VOICE**
- **NEW – (FEB) - On Foot patrols around RIVER WEAVER due to littering**
- **(NEW) FEB – Parking on CALVERLY CLOSE – Now on PATROL PLAN**
- (NOV) More Parking patrols around the area – as you can see from front page, parking is being looked at
- (NOV) Parking issues around THE PAVILLIONS junction of HARTFORD ROAD / EATON LANE – One Vehicle in DECEMBER was given a FIXED PENALTY TICKET

DAVENHAM

- (NOV) - Speed Monitoring on MOUNT PLEASANT / FOUNTAIN LANE / LONDON ROAD (20 MPH SECTION) / HARTFORD ROAD) and CHURCH ROAD at commuter times—**community speed watch is restarting soon—JAN**
- Provide events / things to do for the youths in the community— **We are actively working with partner agencies to look into running youth events—please keep an eye on our social media channels**
- (NOV) Parking Issues at the top of CHURCH ROAD / junction of LONDON ROAD— **Parking patrols are being conducted by PCSO ROBERTSON**
- (NOV) Parking on LONDON ROAD and LABURNUM ROAD—**Any issues witnessed on LONDON ROAD will be issued with FIXED PENALTY TICKETS as it's the main road PCSO ROBERTSON uses to get to MOULTON. So LONDON ROAD is being patrolled. LABURNUM ROAD is a private road so parking can not be addressed.**
- (NOV) 20MPH Signage is in the wrong areas as there is a lot of speeding in the area – **Community Speed watch has now been set up and ready for its 1st session**
- (OCT) PARKING on footpaths on LONDON ROAD—**PATROLS are in place and any issues witnessed are addressed**
- **(DEC & FEB) Parking on the junctions of THE PAVILLIONS / HARTFORD ROAD—Hartford Road is being monitored and a number of vehicles have been issued with FIXED PENALTY TICKETS due to this, with the latest being issued week commencing 20th Dec—area still on PATROL PLAN and there have been no further issues witnessed**
- **(NEW) FEB—Parking on Footpaths Parking on footpaths is allowed—HOWEVER a pram and wheelchair must still be able to get passed and each area will be looked into as some roads / paths were not made for todays vehicles to be fully parked on roads.**
