KEYLESS CAR THEFTS (update)

Due to the recent incidents of KEYLESS CARS being taken within the community, the NORTHWICH SOUTH POLICING TEAM, have started to conduct operations on certain nights.

These operations are covering the areas which have been affected by these crimes. And are looking for any suspicious behavior and conducting stop searches. These operations will continue on various nights in the upcoming months.

We do ask if there is any suspicious activity that you notice, please contact 101 or report via CHESHIRE POLICE website and all reports will be logged as INTEL. And we do thank those residents who have contacted us in regards to suspicious behavior this month especially with vehicle registrations, these are being looked into.

HOW TO KEEP YOURSELF SAFE WITH KEYLESS CARS

For all KEYLESS CAR OWNERS we advise the following :

- When at home keep your car key (and the spare) well away from the car.
- Don't leave keys near the front door or hallway
- Put the keys in a screened or signal-blocking pouch, such as a FARADAY BAG and check if the bag or pouch is still working every few months.
- Reprogramme your keys if you buy a second hand car.
- Turn off wireless signals on your fob when it's not being used.
- If possible keep your keys in a FARADAY BOX

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report in regards to a suspicious vehicle around the COLLEGIATE DRIVE area , as male sat in vehicle for a while with lights off—**Logged in as INTEL , PCSO LEE will try and contact reporting person to see if there is any further issues**

THEFT

Report of a MOBILE PHONE being taken out of reporting persons BAG—**Crimed**

LEFTWICH

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

Report in regards to an ongoing issue with a MALE sending messages and possibly harassing them—**RESPONSE OFFICERS are looking into this**

Report in regards to a MOTORBIKE being driven off road— **Been logged as INTEL and PCSO ROBERTSON to speak to reporting person in regards to this , to get more information**

Report of a MALE shouting abuse and threatening after reported person confronted them over driving at speed— **Vehicle details have been given and placed through as INTEL. PCSO ROBERTSON to conduct a reassurance home visit**

Report of YOUTHS using a LOUD SPEAKER and being noisy—**RESPONSE dispatched and there is no youths present and tried to knock on reporting persons address and there was no answer**

Report of MALE lying in the middle of the road—**MEDICAL issue, family members were alerted and was with male as he suffers from DIABETES**

PARKING OBSTRUCTION

Report of a vehicle being parked on the junction of REDESMERE CLOSE and OLD HALL ROAD —**PCSO LEE dispatched and Vehicle had broken down , owners of the vehicle were at the car trying to jump start the vehicle.**

Second report in regards to the above vehicle—**As vehicle has not been recovered , as been removed by POLICE DUTY GARAGE**

Report of a theft of a parcel —**CRIMED**

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report in regards to a group of youths shining a green laser and shouting abuse at vehicles as they pass by—**RESPONSE OFFICERS were dispatched , search made no trace. PCSO ROBERTSON has the QUEENS HILL on patrol were these youths were sighted and any youths in area , they will be questioned**

Report of a male youth being assaulted by someone in a group and spat at.—**has been crimed. PCSO ROBERTSON to conduct a reassurance visit. Now being assigned to RESPONSE officer**

Report in concern over a colleagues heath after a conversation over the phone stating that they were going to hurt themselves—**RESPONSE dispatched**

DAVENHAM

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report of a GROUP OF YOUTHS leaving the CRICKET CLUB and being loud and being mouthy to reporting person—**NEIGHBOURHOOD POLICING TEAM** being made aware and **PCSO ROBERTSON** to contact reporting person

Report of a DRONE flying over reporting persons address— **RESPONSE** officers have tried to contact reporting person , but no response

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Report of youths causing damage to planters—**Crimed** , **CCTV** has been captured

THEFT

Report of a MALE shoplifting from SPAR—**CCTV** has been viewed and the female identified

MOULTON

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report in regards to a MALE walking in the road, in the oncoming traffic lane and stumberling around—**RESPONSE** dispatched and male located and taken home

Report in regards to aggressive and threatening behaviour from a parent of a child who attends a club which is run by reporting person—**PCSO ROBERTSON** to call round for reassurance

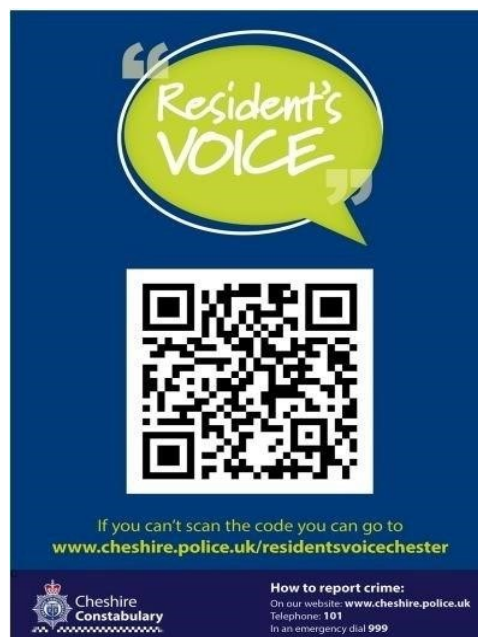
RESIDENTS VOICE – (237 Surveys completed in OCT 23 to MAR 25)

Below is a list of priorities residents have made us aware of , which are on the patrol plan. Updates will be in future newsletters and on Facebook.



In next months NEWSLETTER there will be a dedicated section on PARKING due to the massive response we received in relation to PARKING. PCSO LEE'S PARKING PATROL is conducted all the time when he is in the community in areas which are notified to him. This will be explained fully from next month

WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

- More Patrols in area as there is ASB issues (**No Reports of ASB within the area—2nd month running**)
- NEW (FEB) - Speeding on LONDON ROAD—**Speeding will be looked into after EASTER**
- **NEW (MAR) - People smoking cannabis whilst walking down by the RIVER WEAVER—on foot patrols will be happening around the area after EASTER**

LEFTWICH

- Speed Monitoring on CLIFTON DRIVE / DUNHAM ROAD / LONDON ROAD (30MPH SECTION) and LIME AVE—Speed Camera Sessions will be up and running soon
- More Visibility around WOODPECKER DRIVE area / GRANVILLE ROAD area
- (FEB) Extend the school parking patrols to WOODSIDE TERRACE area— is now included in the school parking patrols
- More patrols around the shops due to ASB issues - CLIFTON DRIVE IS NOW CLASSED AS A HOTSPOT DUE TO ISSUES THAT HAVE BEEN REPORTED AND PATROLS ARE NOW IN PLACE WITH YOUTHS BEING ASKED TO MOVE ON
- Provide something for the youths to be involved in —this is being looked into as we use to have a YOUTH CLUB operating in MOULTON but we just need a building to hold something and put something on
- (JAN) —We need more visibility especially around CLIFTON DRIVE— PATROLS are occurring when PCSO ROBERTSON is on duty. POLICE SURGERIES will now take place in HOT SPOTS and CLIFTON DRIVE will be one of the new locations that will start middle of FEB
- (JAN) - Drug dealers and Drug Use—We actively seeking INTEL / INFORMATION in regards to this and actively work with the community / partner agencies to deal with this. And any good results are always posted on our social media channels. PCSO ROBERTSON has actively been involved with 2 operations with one person being evicted from property and another arrested.
- (FEB) - There should be a ONE WAY SYSTEM around the SCHOOL PICKUP area—Will pass these concerns to RACHEL WATERMAN who is the CWAC representative for LEFTWICH
- FEB—Speeding on DUNHAM ROAD— Speeding will be looked into just like parking , this will happen after EASTER
- FEB—School parking around LEFTWICH PRIMARY and HIGH is becoming an issue again— School parking patrols are occurring and any issued witnessed have been addressed and updates are placed weekly on our social media channels
- FEB—Parking on DUNHAM ROAD—is now placed on PATROL PLAN
- FEB—Parkin on ELLESMERE ROAD—is now placed on PATROL PLAN— Vehicles already been issued ADVISORIES



KINGSMEAD

- Parking patrols on REGENCY WAY just after the ROUNDABOUT— Parking patrols have been conducted by MINI POLICE
- Speed Monitoring on REGENCY WAY and DUKES WAY—Will be included in the MINI POLICE PROGRAM
- School Parking patrols extend to MONARCH DRIVE—Now included in the school parking patrol
- More Patrols around REGENCY WAY RETAIL PARK
- Littering from the students that attend SIR JOHN DEANES—this will be looked into by the MINI POLICE
- Anti Social Behaviour issues around the community—No issues reported since OCTOBER
- Parking patrols around WYNDHAM CLOSE— Parking patrols are taking place
- Parking near KING EDWARDS CLOSE —Parking patrols are now taking place—one resident has been spoken to in regards to parking
- (OCT) PARKING ON DROPPED KERBS around the BICKLEY CLOSE area— Parking patrols now in place
- (DEC) Parking on DRIVEWAYS , people should park on their driveways and not on the road— PCSO Robertson will look into this in the next few weeks to see if there are obstructions caused
- NEW—(JAN) - More parking patrols especially around RESIDENTIAL AREAS—PCSO ROBERTSON is doing parking patrols in areas that have been notified to himself via 101 and RESIDENTS VOICE
- NEW—(FEB) - On Foot patrols around RIVER WEAVER due to littering
- (NEW) FEB—Parking on CALVERLY CLOSE—Now on PATROL PLAN
- (NOV) More Parking patrols around the area— as you can see from front page, parking is being looked at
- (NOV) Parking issues around THE PAVILLIONS junction of HARTFORD ROAD / EATON LANE— One Vehicle in DECEMBER was given a FIXED PENALTY TICKET
- (NOV) Bring up issues relating to CANNANBIS to WEAVER VALE—Are in touch with WEAVER VALE and will raise this up again



DAVENHAM

- (NOV) - Speed Monitoring on MOUNT PLEASANT / FOUNTAIN LANE / LONDON ROAD (20 MPH SECTION) / HARTFORD ROAD) and CHURCH ROAD at commuter times—community speed watch is restarting soon—JAN
- Provide events / things to do for the youths in the community— We are actively working with partner agencies to look into running youth events— please keep an eye on our social media channels
- (NOV) Parking Issues at the top of CHURCH ROAD / junction of LONDON ROAD— Parking patrols are being conducted by PCSO ROBERTSON
- (NOV) Parking on LONDON ROAD and LABURNUM ROAD—Any issues witnessed on LONDON ROAD will be issued with FIXED PENALTY TICKETS as it's the main road PCSO ROBERTSON uses to get to MOULTON. So LONDON ROAD is being patrolled. LABURNUM ROAD is a private road so parking can not be addressed.
- (NOV) 20MPH Signage is in the wrong areas as there is a lot of speeding in the area — Community Speed watch has now been set up and ready for its 1st session
- (OCT) PARKING on footpaths on LONDON ROAD—PATROLS are in place and any issues witnessed are addressed
- (DEC & FEB) Parking on the junctions of THE PAVILLIONS / HARTFORD ROAD—Hartford Road is being monitored and a number of vehicles have been issued with FIXED PENALTY TICKETS due to this , with the latest being issued week commencing 20th Dec—area still on PATROL PLAN and there have been no further issues witnessed
- FEB—Parking on Footpaths Parking on footpaths is allowed—HOWEVER a pram and wheelchair must still be able to get passed and each area will be looked into as some roads / paths were not made for todays vehicles to be fully parked on roads.



MOULTON

- (FEB) - Speed Monitoring on MAIN ROAD / WHITLOW LANE—Speed Gun sessions are re-starting after EASTER
- Speed Gun Sessions not just JACK LANE
- More Visibility around the YARDLEY AVE / RAVENSCROFT areas
- FEB—Inconsiderate parking around the VILLAGE—we are aware of the REGENT STREET BACKS issues which are now putting more vehicles onto the road. Area is placed on PATROL PLAN
- **(NEW) MAR- Regent street backs planning development conditions have not been met and development should not commence—Unfortunately this is not a POLICE MATTER this would have to be brought up to CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER COUNCIL and the PARISH COUNCIL. We have brought up residents concerns in regards to parking and traffic management to the PARISH COUNCIL whilst the development is being conducted.**

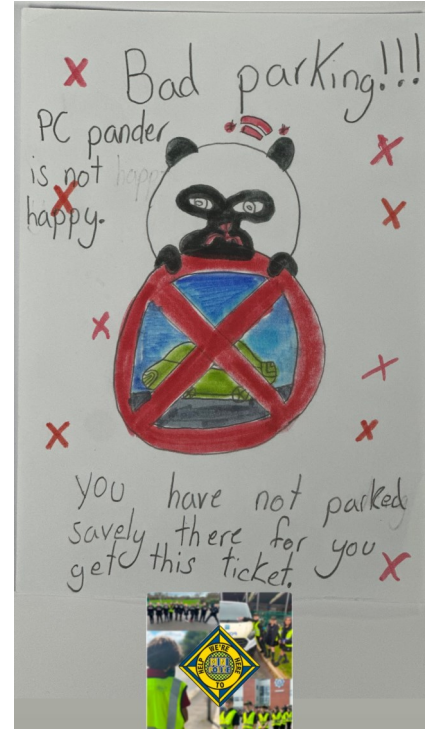


THE MINI POLICE KINGSMEAD

MINI POLICE PRODUCE PARKING TICKETS

Ever since PCSO LEE spoke to the MINI POLICE in regards to parking and developing their parking promise, they have been designing parking tickets, ready for their parking patrols.

They produced both "THANK YOU FOR PARKING CORRECTLY" and "BAD PARKING" tickets.



THE IMPROVED PARKING PATROLS

Last year when the MINI POLICE conducted parking patrols, they conducted them just in the afternoon and in areas surrounding the school. This year together with surround areas of the school, the MINI POLICE also conducted patrols:

- in areas that are highlighted by residents (SANDBACH DRIVE)
 - as residents contacted PCSO LEE in relation to people parking on footpaths. A number of BAD PARKING tickets were issued
 - Around the college area due to past issues in relation to parking
 - With previous issues involving students parking off site, the MINI POLICE just wanted to see if there were any issues witness. Two bad parking tickets were issued for people parking opposite the junction
 - Disabled Bays within the REGENCY WAY RETAIL PACK
 - The MINI POLICE wanted to help those who required the disabled bays, by giving out a number of BAD PARKING TICKETS to those who were using the bays without a blue badge
- These patrols were also conducted in the MORNING and AFTERNOON.

THE PARKING PROMISE GIVEN TO SHOPS

The MINI POLICE spoke to staff at the DOCTORS SURGERY , BARNARDOS and PHARMACY on the RETAIL PARK to ask if their PARKING PROMISE can be left within the shops / surgery so that they can be given out to the people who use their services .

After that they were asked to produce parking tickets both GOOD and BAD for their parking patrols and to design a leaflet which will be their PARKING PROMISE to be given to all parents.
