We are receiving reports through out the community of DRUG RELATED ISSUES. These may include :

- Possible drug dealings , due to suspicious behaviour
- Drug usage including Cannabis

— Cannabis is still an illegal drug —

When we receive these reports they all go to INTELLIGENCE and the more reports / Intelligence we received , the bigger the picture we can build. As our main priority is to catch those who have drugs in their possession and to reduce / help those who use.

WE NEED YOU !!

Our residents are our eyes and ears and without reports to 101 or intel (provided to your community officers) we cant build this picture up to catch those we need to catch.

If we conduct patrols of possible areas that Drug Dealing may be happening , then this will simply more the issue to another location within our community. Where as if we have a bigger picture we can put a plan of action into place.

When a report is made, PCSO Robertson will complete a reassurance visit and gain more information, which would be filled as Intelligence. With that, the reporting person would be supplied with PCSO Robertsons EMAIL ADDRESS, so if there is further information it can be passed via email. So if there are issues please report them to 101 and if there are further issues relating please email your community police.

Report in regards to two males using off ride bikes on a footpath near WOODSIDE TERRACE

PCSO ROBERTSON is aware of this and it is just patrolling at the right time to catch them as there is no pattern to the issues.

This has been submitted as INTEL

Report in regards to someone banging on front door

RESPONSE OFFICERS attended , no description of the person , and no one present in immediate area

Report in regards to a NEIGHBOUR possibly causing issues due to noise

Safeguarding advice given and PCSO ROBERTSON will contact reporting person

Report in regards to a MALE being aggressive outside a location and using threatening language

RESPONSE officers dispatched and MALE ARRESTED

Report of someone being in reporting persons BACKGARDEN, another person was with reporting person as the time , but they didn't see anyone.

PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance home visit

Report of a MALE being unconscious in the road on CLIFTON DRIVE , possibly been knocked off his bike.

AMBULANCE called and male taken to hospital

Report of an ex partner messaging stating that they will turn up at the address of the reporting person

SAFEGUARDING ADVICE given , PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit

Report of reporting persons son being threatened after an incident involving a female.

PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance with PC BOX

Report in regards to suspicious activity involving vehicles around the RICHMOND DRIVE area

Information has been logged as INTEL—PCSO ROBERTSON will conducted home visit.

Report in regards to reporting person being woken up by BANGING , sounding like a shed door being kicked in, possibly being broken into

RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched and searched area , no trace of anything suspicious

Report in regards to a neighbour being threatening and holding a hedge trimmer towards them , intimidating them

PCSO ROBERTSON will contact reporting person for reassurance and to see if there are further issues

Report of two MALES riding dangerously on CLIFTON DRIVE. Details have been passed in regards to who these males are.

PCSO ROBERTSON and PC BOX have got the details and will put patrols in place , as if this is witnessed , the vehicles will be seized. PCSO ROBERTSON will contact reporting person regarding this

Report of YOUTHS running across garden and being in the back garden

PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit

Report of a LOUD BANG at front door and reporting person finding a YOUNG MALE demanding to be let inside as he was scared, and another male was hiding around the corner

YOUTHS ran off, as reporting persons husband scared them off. Incident happened 20 mins before report and no direction of travel, therefore no deployment. PCSO ROBERTSON will conducted reassurance visit

Report of a FEMALE taking too may sleeping tablets and feeling funny

AMBULANCE incident and female taken to hospital

Report in regards to two males riding OFFROAD BIKES on the footpath and nearly knocking reporting person over.

PCSO ROBERTSON is aware of this and is gathering as much information so patrols can be put into place to catch these males. PCSO ROBERTSON will also conduct REASSURANCE VISIT. RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched search made no trace of the males

Report of someone smashing things up

RESPONSE dispatched and MALE ARRESTED

Report of threats to reporting persons daughter, being received over a phone call from a withheld number

PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct REASSURANCE visit when back off leave

Report of a MALE lying in field , eyes closed and shoes off

MALE possibly intoxicated—caller advised to call AMBULANCE

Report of reporting persons daughter receiving disturbing calls

PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct REASSURANCE VISIT when back off leave

Report of possible threats and assaults from someone who Reporting person would not name / identify.

PCSO ROBERTSON has tried to contact reporting person in the past to no success. However due to threats made on the report in regards police , as there has no contact from reporting person , there will be no further attempts unless necessary

Has been inputted as INTEL , and vehicle details have been passed to officers. PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct telephone reassurance call

Report of a MALE being caught on RING DOOR CAMERA going down the side of his house.

Reporting person put on lights , which possibly scared the male off.

Report of 2 VANS acting suspiciously in the GREEN LANE area

2nd report (on different day) in regards to suspicious activity of two males leaving vehicle and just walking to edge of footpath

PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit. Information for the vehicles have been placed as INTEL

Report of a MALE being INTOXICATED and refusing to the leave the BULLS HEAD

2nd report of TWO MALES causing issues within the ODDFELLOWS

RESPONSE officers dispatched and located males who immediately left the area. No Arrests were made as both reporting people did not make complaints , just wanted them to leave the area.

Report of screaming and shouting coming from a property and there is a strong smell on CANNABIS

RESPONSE officers dispatched. There is no concerns , as there are a few people round for dinner which has took longer to make , which has caused some disagreements. There is no smell of CANNABIS and no signs of drug use

Report of a post on FACEBOOK stating that a MALE tried to take someones bike

Report made to 101 in regards to the above incident—and was just logging the incident

Information provided has been inputted as INTEL , PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit when back off LEAVE

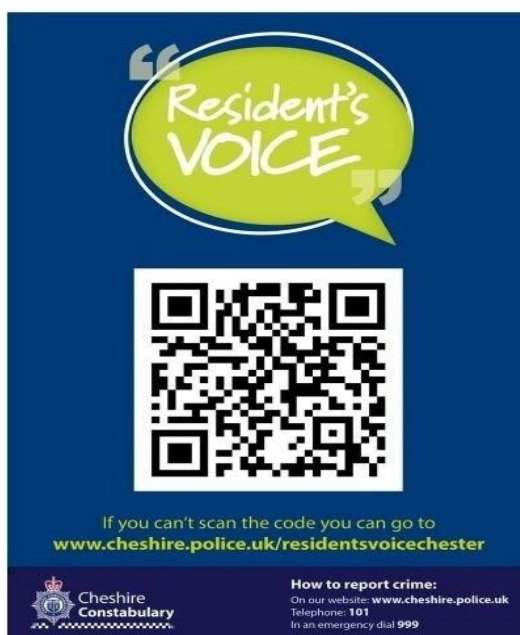
RESIDENTS VOICE – (281 Surveys completed in OCT 23 to MAY 25)

WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

- More Patrols in area as there is ASB issues (**No Reports of ASB within the area—2nd month running**)
- NEW (FEB) - Speeding on LONDON ROAD—**Speeding will be looked into after EASTER**
- NEW (MAR) - People smoking cannabis whilst walking down by the RIVER WEAVER—**on foot patrols will be happening around the area after EASTER**

LEFTWICH PREVIOUS ISSUES



- Speed Monitoring on CLIFTON DRIVE / DUNHAM ROAD / LONDON ROAD (30MPH SECTION) and LIME AVE—Speed Camera Sessions will be up and running soon
- More Visibility around WOODPECKER DRIVE area / GRANVILLE ROAD area
- More patrols around the shops due to ASB issues
- CLIFTON DRIVE IS NOW CLASSED AS A HOTSPOT DUE TO ISSUES THAT HAVE BEEN REPORTED AND PATROLS ARE NOW IN PLACE WITH YOUTHS BEING ASKED TO MOVE ON
- Provide something for the youths to be involved in —this is being looked into as we use to have a YOUTH CLUB operating in MOULTON but we just need a building to hold something and put something on
- (JAN) —We need more visibility especially around CLIFTON DRIVE— PATROLS are occurring when PCSO ROBERTSON is on duty. POLICE SURGERIES will now take place in HOT SPOTS and CLIFTON DRIVE will be one of the new locations that will start middle of FEB
- (JAN) - Drug dealers and Drug Use—We actively seeking INTEL / INFORMATION in regards to this and actively work with the community / partner agencies to deal with this. And any good results are always posted on our social media channels. PCSO ROBERTSON has actively been involved with 2 operations with one person being evicted from property and another arrested.
- (FEB) - There should be a ONE WAY SYSTEM around the SCHOOL PICKUP area—Will pass these concerns to RACHEL WATERMAN who is the CWAC representative for LEFTWICH
- FEB—Speeding on DUNHAM ROAD— Speeding will be looked into just like parking , this will happen after EASTER
- (APR)—Slow Drivers – Unfortunately if people are being safe on roads by reducing their speed , this is not a police matter. This is what we want to happen to keep everyone safe on roads
- (APR) - Keep young people safe—we do attend schools and give out talks / presentations to schools , when schools request them. When there is ASB issues patrols are put into place to prevent further ASB. If there are people known to us involved in ASB or anything else , home visits with chats with parents present does take place.
- (APR) Drug related issues—any information about this , should be passed to 101 / CRIMESTOPPERS or your local policing team via emails which are on the first page of the newsletter
- (APR) Gangs of Teens causing issues—we are aware of issues on CLIFTON DRIVE reason why patrols in place. But further issues need to be reported to 101

LEFTWICH

NEW ISSUES

- Speed Monitoring on OLD HALL ROAD as vehicles seem to be reaching 40MPH + - **Speed Monitoring will take place on OLD ROAD in due course**
- Parked cars on OLD HALL ROAD , especially parking on footpaths , there is one vehicle in particular , parks on footpath and cant get past—**Parking on footpaths is allowed—HOWEVER a pram and wheelchair must still be able to get passed. OLD HALL ROAD has been place on parking patrol plan. There has been nothing witnessed as of yet**
- Be more visible on side roads in LEFTWICH—**we are going to be more visible in areas which are getting reports**



KINGSMEAD

PREVIOUS ISSUES

- Speed Monitoring on REGENCY WAY and DUKES WAY—Will be included in the MINI POLICE PROGRAM
- More Patrols around REGENCY WAY RETAIL PARK
- Littering from the students that attend SIR JOHN DEANES—this will be looked into by the MINI POLICE
- Anti Social Behaviour issues around the community—No issues reported since OCTOBER
- (DEC) Parking on DRIVEWAYS , people should park on their driveways and not on the road— PCSO Robertson will look into this in the next few weeks to see if there are obstructions caused
- (JAN) - More parking patrols especially around RESIDENTIAL AREAS—PCSO ROBERTSON is doing parking patrols in areas that have been notified to himself via 101 and RESIDENTS VOICE
- (FEB) - On Foot patrols around RIVER WEAVER due to littering
- (NOV) More Parking patrols around the area— as you can see from front page, parking is being looked at
- (NOV) Bring up issues relating to CANNANBIS to WEAVER VALE—Are in touch with WEAVER VALE and will raise this up again
- (APR) Vehicles getting damaged —This should be reported to 101. How are they getting damaged ? There has been no CRIMINAL DAMAGE reports in regards to vehicles in the KINGSMEAD AREA
- (APR) To prevent ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR—we do attend schools and give out talks / presentations to schools , when schools request them. When there is ASB issues patrols are put into place to prevent further ASB. But if there are issues of ASB they would need to be reported to 101
- (APR) Noisy Vehicles that make a huge noise when being revved— Unfortunately vehicle specifications are not down to the police , but however if there is a vehicle that has been customed and is making excessive noise this would need to be reported to 101 , with vehicle details
- (APR) Car parked on BICKLEY CLOSE and has not moved for past 3 months—There is a time scale that we need to adhere to before possible abandoned cars are reported to the local council. As this vehicle is approaching the deadline of being abandoned it will be reported to CWAC , by PCSO ROBERTSON

NEW ISSUES

- Speeding on The KINGSMEAD SPINE ROAD— Speeding has been looked into on here when officers and MINI POLICE have conducted speed gun sessions. An all day session only caught 2 people, but it will be conducted again



KINGSMEAD

NEW ISSUES (cont)

- Parking around the college is becoming an issue and is a regular problem—There has only been 2 reports in regards to this since Summer 2024. It is not down to the college on how students park , and students don't have to use the car park facilities. It is down to the actual Student / driver, if they are causing an obstruction then they will be given a FIXED PENALTY TICKET. Sir John Deanes college does work alongside PCSO ROBERTSON , and due to residents concerns , the college cones have been moved from MONARCH DRIVE to WYNDHAM CLOSE junction. This area is on the parking patrol plan and if there are any issues it will be issued a FIXED PENALTY NOTICE
- Parking on WYNDHAM CLOSE—Please see above
- Parking on SEAGRAVE CLOSE— This is in relation to the college , when this was first notified at the beginning of MAY , PCSO ROBERTSON conducted parking patrols—in which there was no issues witnessed
- Dangerous Parking on CAPESTRONE due to the college— please see above



DAVENHAM

PREVIOUS ISSUES

- (NOV) - Speed Monitoring on MOUNT PLEASANT / FOUNTAIN LANE / LONDON ROAD (20 MPH SECTION) / HARTFORD ROAD and CHURCH ROAD at commuter times—community speed watch is restarting soon—JAN
- Provide events / things to do for the youths in the community— We are actively working with partner agencies to look into running youth events—please keep an eye on our social media channels
- (NOV) 20MPH Signage is in the wrong areas as there is a lot of speeding in the area — Community Speed watch has now been set up and ready for its 1st session
- FEB—Parking on Footpaths Parking on footpaths is allowed—HOWEVER a pram and wheelchair must still be able to get passed and each area will be looked into as some roads / paths were not made for today's vehicles to be fully parked on roads.



NEW ISSUES

- Speeding and Parking Issues on FOUNTAIN LANE—Speed Monitoring will occur on FOUNTAIN LANE, but there has not been issues of Parking on FOUNTAIN LANE as of yet
- Speeding on HARTFORD ROAD especially in the Morning—This is being looked into, as PCSO ROBERTSON has conducted speed monitoring on HARTFORD ROAD in passes and noticed this was an issue
- More Police on BEAT— Hopefully the new pledge / funding for community policing will come though, but will take some time
- In Davenham, the biggest issue is parking. FAIRHOLME ROAD it is usually unsafe to turn in to due to cars parked by the junction.—This is now on parking patrols and there has been no issues witnessed. Residents do not have to park on driveways as this was also a part of the concern
- Cars speed down JACK LANE like it is a race track, and LONDON ROAD too. - Speed Gun Sessions will take place on here. JACK LANE was an enforcement road, but however with the speed bumps in place there were no offences captured
- Deal with parking issues at the weekends, around the village—LONDON ROAD is on the patrol plan and a number of vehicles have been issued FIXED PENALTY NOTICES

MOULTON

PREVIOUS ISSUES

- (FEB) - Speed Monitoring on MAIN ROAD / WHITLOW LANE—Speed Gun sessions are re-starting after EASTER
- Speed Gun Sessions not just JACK LANE
- More Visibility around the YARDLEY AVE / RAVENSCROFT areas
- FEB—Inconsiderate parking around the VILLAGE—we are aware of the REGENT STREET BACKS issues which are now putting more vehicles onto the road. Area is placed on PATROL PLAN
- MAR- Regent street backs planning development conditions have not been met and development should not commence—Unfortunately this is not a POLICE MATTER this would have to be brought up to CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER COUNCIL and the PARISH COUNCIL. We have brought up residents concerns in regards to parking and traffic management to the PARISH COUNCIL whilst the development is being conducted.
- (APR)- A crack down on bad driving / speeding and parking to make our roads safer – When it comes to bad driving if there are issues with a certain vehicle , this would need to be reported to 101 , with vehicle details ,as police cant patrol all roads. When a report comes in , this then gets passed to ALL PATROLS to look out of the vehicle. When it comes to speeding , which roads are the concern, so speed monitoring can take place. Parking , we do understand parking in MOULTON is an issue at present with the developments taking place , but we are still patrolling area for bad obstructions.
- (APR) Parking—REGENT STREET—We understand due to the development that parking has been impacted , however there is the car park next to the park , which we have been informed by PARISH COUNCIL , can be used



NEW ISSUES

- * Parking on the junction of YARDLEY / RAVENSCROFT—This has been on the parking patrol before in which there was no issues witnessed. However this will go back onto the parking patrol plan.
