## DRUG RELATED ISSUES— DAVENHAM

Over the past month there has been an increase in suspicious behavior around the Mount Pleasant area and with that there has been an increase in police presence (RESPONSE OFFICERS) and all relate to drug related issues.

This led to an arrest of 4 people on the 31st July.

The arrest of 4 people would not of happened if it wasn't for patrols that were put into place, due to information that we were receiving. So with that we are asking if there is anything that you see (no matter which area) that it is communicated to ourselves through the following ways:

## NEW LOCATION FOR POLICE SURGERIES

POLICE SURGERIES are an excellent way to speak to your local policing team—PCSO ROBERTSON and PC BOX. The police surgeries are held in areas at certain times and officers will be fully available at that time to speak to all those who attend.

In the past the DAVENHAM MOULTON surgeries were held at WEAVER HALL salt museum, which through residents feedback were not suitable due to the distance some residents have to travel.

With that surgeries were held in each area :

LEFTWICH—Clifton drive

KINGSMEAD—Regency way shops

DAVENHAM—Spar

MOULTON—Crows nest café.

And through feedback again , these were stopped as some areas only had officers in the police cars , which some residents felt uncomfortable approaching.

We now have a suitable area to hold our police surgeries every month going forward , which is the DAVENHAM BRITISH LEGION , which is very central for the DAVENHAM AND MOULTON community. Every month PCSO ROBERTSON will be at the British legion at the same times , so you can attend and speak to him with any issues or concerns.

There is also KINGSMEAD PRIMARY SCHOOL which PCSO ROBERTSON can book in advance if there is a need for an evening surgery , and PCSO ROBERTSON will do on street police surgeries, if there is need, such as WYNDHAM CLOSE when there was issues with parking.

Feed back will also be listened to , and if you feel that you would like a surgery in your area , due to an ongoing issue then please contact PCSO ROBERTSON using his email (which is on the front page)

# WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

## ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Male appears drunk on a INFLATABLE KAYAK on RIVER WEAVER—**PCSO's are committed at the CROWS FAIR and PCS are at CHESTER RACES . RESPONSE OFFICERS are not available**
- YOUTHS have tried a rope to the bridge and using it as a swing on RIVER WEAVER—**PCSO's are committed at the CROWS FAIR and PCS are at CHESTER RACES . RESPONSE OFFICERS are not available**
- MOTORBIKE on the footpath alongside RIVER WEAVER, constant issue—**This is the first report in regards to this , PCSO ROBERTSON will try and speak to reporting person in regards to this to gain more information so that a patrol can be put in place.**
- FEMALE hurt herself using a KNIFE— **AMBULANCE involved and female discharged herself**
- Concerns over a FEMALE after sending a message to a friend— **Female is now in hospital**
- Further concerns over the health of the FEMALE above—**Not a police issues , passed to AMBULANCE due to right care right place**
- MALE hanging around a communal area, drinking , smoking and listening to music and wont leave—**RESPONSE officers attended and moved the male on.**
- Children have been accused of stealing and grabbed in a shop—**PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct some CCTV checks and visit both the shop and reporting person for more information. There has been no report of theft**
- Female shouted at reporting persons brother for parking a car in a communal area. Then the female moved her vehicle as close as they can to the brothers vehicle. Car door was opened onto the brothers vehicle and then there was a small scratch , which led to heated words being exchanged—**PCSO ROBERTSON will speak to all parties in regard to this**

# LEFTWICH

## ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- MALE YOUTH rang 101 and there was no clear indication of the issue due to MIXED MESSAGES on the phone call—**RESPONSE officers attended, issue related to MALE YOUTH being pushed off bike by another youth. Both of their stories did not add up and both were spoken to and sent home.**
- Ongoing neighbour issues in relation to noise and disturbances—**PCSO ROBERTSON is working with WEAVER VALE in regards to this issue**
- Issues with neighbour have now started up again—**This is at an address which is not known to PCSO ROBERTSON so is unsure about these previous issues which have started up again. Home reassurance visit will happen**
- Neighbour shouting abuse as they came home and entered their own house—**PCSO ROBERTSON will speak to reporting person and the neighbour**
- Female found lying face down on the grass outside of the WOODPECKER—screaming and crying saying she ran away from someone—**Whilst on call to police , female got up and got a taxi**
- Threats and abuse from teenagers ,to the reporting person—**RESPONSE OFFICERS have attended ALL ADDRESSES and spoke to all parties and safeguarding advice given. This is due to a friendship ending and there has been disagreements between all parties—PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit**
- 2 MALE TEENAGERS playing loud music in a garage of a VULNERABLE FEMALES property—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched and males spoken to , they were doing some garden work for the female. Advised to turn the music down**
- Screaming and shouting coming from the next door neighbours which is concerning—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched—there was a health issue which therefore AMBULANCE was called**

## HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTIONS

- Van and car parked on the junction of LONDON ROAD , which is making its difficult to pul out of Junction—**PCSO DONNELLY (HARTFORD AND GREENBANK) was dispatched due to PCSO ROBERTSON attending incident in NORTHWICH TOWN CENTRE. Owner of vehicles located and vehicles moved—words of advice given**
- Van parking across residents driveway on ELLESMERE ROAD—**PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit**
- Vehicle lost power due to a fuel leak—**Vehicle moved onto a car park so wasn't causing obstructions**

## THEFT

- Reporting person provided money to a garden due to a quote and the gardener used that money to fix their van.— **Has been CRIMED**

## THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

- Reporting person bought a bike of another party and took the bike to another party to fix it up. Other party is now refusing to return this , stating that they also bought the bike—**CIVAL MATTER**

# KINGSMEAD

## ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Male and Female youths smashing bottles and shouting slurs at people who are passing by—**PCSO ROBERTSON may know who this is due to description. He will speak to the reporting person to find out the location this occurred and then if it is the male he knows , a home address will be made.**
- Reporting persons daughter was grabbed by a older MALE in MOULTON PARK—**PCSO ROBERTSON will get in touch with MOULTON PARISH COUNCIL to view CCTV and speak to REPORTING PERSON**
- Fight happening outside the KINGFISHER—**RESPONSE officers dispatched and no fight on arrival**
- Concern over a female due to the fact that she just received bad news from someone , and then called them back to say—She wants to end it all—**RIGHT CARE RIGHT PLACE—AMBULANCE should be notified for this**
- Concern over the possibility that someone may have died due to a strong smell , but unsure where its coming from. Reporting person had just dropped off relative and can not ask that relative to knock on the addresses they think this smell is coming from—**No deployment unless further calls**
- Neighbour shouting abuse and possibly leaving notes—**PCSO ROBERTSON will contact the reporting person in regards to this for more of a background**
- YOUTHS riding on reporting person garden—**PC COLLICT attended and there was no sign of the youths and spoke to the Reporting Person. PCSO ROBERTSON will contact Reporting person when back in the community**
- Two males fishing in the pond on CORONET AVENUE—**PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct patrols around the area of the time the report as been made. And will conduct a home visit to the reporting person**
- YOUTHS throwing sticks over the fence and shouting abusive language—**PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct patrols in and around the area at time stated on the report**

## FRAUD

- An ONLINE ACCOUNT being hacked and purchases being made.— **Safeguarding advice given and PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit**

## SHOPLIFTING

- Male has walked out with basket full of meat at TESCO KINGSMEAD—**CCTV will be requested**
- Two male youths ran out of store with a crate of beer—**CCTV will checked and requested**

# DAVENHAM

## ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- GROUP OF YOUTHS on BUTCHERS STILE at 23:09—**PCSO ROBERTSON will view CCTV to see if there is any ASB offences , as it is a public park**
- Number of youths on BUTCHERS STILE when sign says it can not be used after 2200—**This is a public space and can not be closed. These times are advisories. PCSO ROBERTSON has checked CCTV and they are in the middle of the field playing frisbee. No youths present when CCTV is checked at 22:35. report was made at 22:23**
- Male grabbed a child in MOULTON PARK and gave parents abuse—**PCSO ROBERTSON will speak to reporting person as this issue related to another issue that is being looked into by RESPONSE and PCSO ROBERTSON**
- Loud music being played on BUTCHERS STILE at 22:27 when the park closes at 2200—**CCTV will be checked by PCSO ROBERTSON and youths leave before 2300 – CCTV signs will be put up by PARISH COUNCIL**
- Drug Dealing in the area of MOUNT PLEASANT ROAD—**Has been placed in as INTEL**
- YOUTHS drinking by the POND AREA of BUTCHERS STILE and parent hitting one of the Youths—
- YOUTHS playing football on BUTCHERS STILE at 2207—**CCTV ,has been checked at the time of the time call. Youths on bikes on dirt track , youths playing football and dog walkers present , no ASB issues caused CCTV signs will be put up by PARISH COUNCIL**
- YOUTHS causing issues on BUTCHERS STILE and there is a CURFEW at 2200—**CCTV has been checked at the time of the call at 2207 there are youths playing football and sat down. 20 mins later they all leave. Have requested PARISH COUNCIL to remove the times off the sign , as there is NO CURFEW. No issues caused by youths**
- Male fishing at the DAVENHAM PITS who is not a member , when confronted there some verbal abuse shouted at the reporting person - **RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched and male spoken to, packed and left the area.**

## ROAD RELATED OFFENCES

- Vehicle constantly driving possibly over 50MPH on HARTFORD ROAD—**Vehicle details have been logged as INTEL and vehicle will be stopped if seen. Plus patrols will be put on by PCSO ROBERTSON at the times reporting person has mentioned**

## BURGLARY

- \* Someone trying to break into property— **RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched—the reporting person was stating that it was another property that they thought that was getting broken into. Officers checked that property , and there was no cause for concern.**

# MOULTON

## ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- MALE riding a MOTORBIKE constantly up and down the road - **Has been logged , but nothing unlawful**
- A number of YOUTHS , doing KNOCK AND RUN, which is an ongoing issues (3 reports) —**PCSO ROBERTSON was alerted to this last year and Reporting person only wanted to log the issue. Therefore PCSO ROBERTSON will attend address and see if there is any CCTV**
- Postal worker was shouted abuse in regards to parking, and a car door was shoved into his chest—**OFFICERS are looking into this as the reporting person is from MIDDLEWICH**
- Two reports in regards to a male acting suspiciously in front of property , banging and running away—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched and Search Made No Trace— RESPONSE OFFICERS updated reporting person—PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct REASSURANCE**
- Concern over a female after sending images and messages in relation to her children—**RESPONSE OFFICERS attended , there is no concern over the children , but female has been to HOSPITAL**
- Two reports regarding MALES on the park trying to hit children with sticks and possibly selling drugs—**PCSO ROBERTSON will contact both reporting people to get more information. CCTV will be requested from MOULTON PARISH COUNCIL**

## ANIMALS

- Reporting persons partner was bitten 3 times by a dog at an address - **Safeguarding advice given and PCSO will contact the reporting person**

# BOSTOCK

## HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION

- Cow in the the middle of the road , reporting person managed to get Cow into a nearby field and close the gate , but is concerned there may be an opening

# THE MINI POLICE KINGSMEAD

## MINI POLICE CONTINUE TO TEACH YEAR 4 ROAD SAFETY

Last month the MINI POLICE completed their LETS WALK TRAINING on wet day , which taught them the GREEN CROSS CODE and how to cross the roads more safely. Then they began teaching the year 4 children what they had learnt. Last month the MINI POLICE only taught half of the year , and this month they continued and everyone from year 4 was taught on how to cross the roads more safely.

## MINI POLICE TACKLE SPEEDING.

One of the most requesting activities / patrols that MINI POLICE request to do is the SPEED CAMERA. And within the MINI POLICE PROGRAM , JULY has become the month for them to pick up the speed gun and zap away. PCSO LEE trained all of the Mini Police on how to use the speed gun and how to read the speed that every vehicle that they zapped was going.

Speed Camera sessions were conducted on the A533 , due to residents feedback and a total of 7 sessions was completed, each session lasting 30 minutes.

One MINI POLICE officer was using the Speed Gun and the other MINI POLICE that were in the team held up signs to alert people of their speeding.

40MPH and below , got the big thumbs up sign

Over 40MPH got the big red thumbs down sign.

Over the course of the 7 sessions , 7 offences were captured with the highest speed being 49 MPH. All of these offences were processed by PCSO LEE





# THE MINI POLICE DAVENHAM

## DAVENHAM MINI POLICE TACKLE SPEEDING

As stated JULY is the month that MINI POLICE tackle speeding, so with the the DAVENHAM MINI POLICE picked up the speed camera and conducted their speed camera sessions on LONDON ROAD. Once again PCSO LEE taught every MINI POLICE officer how to use the SPEED CAMERA and how to read the speed that each vehicle was going when zapped. Just like the KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE , one MINI POLICE officer had the camera and the other MINI POLICE had the signs.

If any driver was travelling 20 MPH or below then they got the green thumbs up sign.

If any driver was travelling 21MPH or above , then got the red thumbs down sign.

6 sessions were completed with a total of 13 offences captured. All of the offences are being processed by PCSO LEE , but the MINI POLICE have not quite finished with these vehicles yet.



## DAVENHAM LUNCH BECOMES A PART OF THE DAVENHAM MINI POLICE PROGRAM

We are happy to announce that a new part of the MINI POLICE PROGRAM has been introduced and that is the DAVENHAM LUNCH. Each month the ROYAL BRITISH LEGION and DAVENHAM PARISH COUNCIL put on a lunch for the residents of the community. PCSO LEE has been a regular guest , attending and chatting to residents that attend. Now going forward PCSO LEE will not be alone , he will also have his MINI POLICE with him. They will be there to help PCSO LEE and speak to the residents about the MINI POLICE program.
