058: Reports noted from CW, (came in on 14<sup>th</sup> July and circulated) We noted they had not weeded Monarch Drive Park or watered the planter at the Northwich end of the estate but apart from that the grass cutting was good.

b) We considered the option and cost of blocking off the short cuts and concluded this was a last resort at this stage

c) next actions are to write to those residents with immediate access to the top path through the back of their properties and ask nicely if they could refrain from using the access.

Also to get signs made for all the other short cuts which were currently being used to explain, it's a wildlife strip etc and private land. Suitable wording to be agreed with clerk and chair.

a) Orchard, ok with that but do we need another quote, if not go ahead in October.

b) Approve pruning of oak at Capstone and Stretton. Caddis to do.

c) Crown lifting and dead tree removal dukes Ways. Caddis to do.

d) Crown lifting and crown reduction at Blandford/Regency. Caddis to do.

e) Crown lifting and crown reduction at Shavington. Caddis to do.

f) Lime tree Crown lifting on Regency. Caddis to do, we noted we do not want these trees Pollarding.

g) Crown lifting, pruning back and removal dead trees on cycle path A533. Cheshire tree and garden to do.

h) Cutting back of trees and re-establishing boundary break at Ellingham. Cheshire tree and garden to do.

058.5 Solar lights at sign, defer for more quotes, but if this is the only quote, we can go with it.

058.6 We noted that the letter was delivered and the residents who owns the land has take appropriate action and the reporting resident thanked us.

059. Noted the costs of the play area resurfacing, we need more quotes but also put this within the long-term strategy for all the parks, once it's been pulled together.
