

ASK THE CHIEF CONSTABLE WHY HE WANTS TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF PCSOs IN CHESHIRE

Cheshire Constabulary has proposed a major re-organisation of its PCSO service, reducing numbers from **87 to 27** across the county. PCSO's play a vital role in our community and the Parish Council is **concerned about the impact** this change will have in Kingsmead.

If you are also concerned about these changes, here are some questions to ask the Chief Constable about this decision:

- What is the main reason behind the decision to reduce PCSO numbers?
- How will community engagement in Kingsmead be affected?
- Who will take on the duties currently managed by PCSOs?
- What financial savings are expected from the reduction in the number of PCSOs?
- Is this measure temporary or permanent?
- Will there be opportunities for PCSOs to re-train or move into other roles?
- How is the potential redundancy of such a large number of staff being funded?
