But any community issues will be looked into by PCSO HAMBLETON , but please bear with him as he will be the PCSO for the following areas :

- DAVENHAM AND MOULTON (including Leftwich , Kingsmead, Bostock)
- RUDHEATH
- HARTFORD AND GREENBANK
- SHAKERLEY

PC BOX will still continue to be the Police officer for DAVENHAM AND MOULTON area.

PCSO ROBERTSON will continue to conduct patrols around the community and place updates on this channel. From the 1st April when he becomes the Town Centre PCSO he will also transfer to our main social media channel - NORTHWICH POLICE and post updates regards his work there. With one of his first issues that he will be tackling is the youth issues within the Town Centre.

# WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

## ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Two people

### THEFT OF MOTOR VEHICLE

- Car taken from area— **CRIMED and being investigated**

# LEFTWICH

## ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

- Caller contacting police in regards to being dismissed from work which occurred 2 years previously—**Not a police matter so closed by operator**
- Issue in regards to neighbour drilling , as it sounds like they are drilling into the reporting persons address.—**PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit**
- Suspicious activity coming from the property next door to reporting persons—**Has been logged as Intel**

## ANIMALS

- Dog got loose from an address and grabbed POST OFFICE delivery persons coat—**RESPONSE officer attended the address and spoke to owner of the Dog. There is damage to the fence due to the bad weather. As there was no injuries, advice was given.**

### THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE

- Copper stolen from a Van whilst working on telegraph poles —**Crimed**

## BURGULARY

- Theres movement in an address and there is a flashlight being used —**False alarm everyone is safe and well**
- Male kicking at the front door and trying to gain entry—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched—search of area conducted, no trace of male.**

# MOULTON

## ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- Unresponsive female in a HOT TUB— **regained consciousness during call , AMBULANCE notified**

## HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION

- Large number of sheep walking through estate and heading towards to A533—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatche— all sheep are secure within another field**

# KINGSMEAD

## ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

- 4 males approached reporting persons son on bike and asked numerous things, in which the son declined and tried to move off. However the males caught up and started to damage the bike and assault the son.—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched and spoke to son in regards to the incident. PCSO ROBERTSON is looking at CCTV to see if these males have been spotted in area.**
- Two males shouting abuse whilst on ELECTRIC SCOOTERS—**RESPONSE OFFICERS dispatched and search of area made—no trace of the males**
- Male rider is smelling of CANNABIS— **ASB Callback made by PCSO GILLETT and information passed to PCSO ROBERTSON. INTEL has been inputted.**

## HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION

- Two vehicles parking too close to each other (double parked) which has blocked WYNDHAM CLOSE—**PCSO ROBERTSON attended and located driver who was given strong words of advice and vehicle moved**

- \* Two males have dumped items on reporting persons doorstep—**PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit to view RING DOOR footage.**

Even though PCSO ROBERTSON is moving onto NORTHWICH TOWN CENTRE , the MINI POLICE program will still continue with him , as he will still be working with :

- KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE + KINGSMEAD PARISH COUNCIL
- DAVENHAM MINI POLICE + DAVENHAM PARISH COUNCIL
- LEFTWICH MINI POLICE + LEFTWICH PRIMARY SCHOOL

And will be taking over the HARTFORD MINI POLICE.

## Kingsmead Mini Police start their parking patrols

Since the Mini Police asked all parents to sign their parking promise , the Mini Police wanted to see if parents were keeping to their promise. So with that they started to conduct parking patrols around the community.

This included the following roads :

- DUKES WAY - BUCKINGHAM DRIVE  
- REGAL CLOSE
- MONARCH DRIVE - BLANDFORD DRIVE

There was a number of issues with bad parking which resulted in BAD PARKING tickets and even speaking to a number of drivers to ask them not to park like that again





## Leftwich & Davenham Mini Police start their Parking Promise

Before they start their parking patrols with PCSO ROBERTSON , the Mini Police have to learn about

- what is classed as good and bad parking
- Issues that bad parking creates
- What the Mini Police are going to do to tackle the issues of parking around the community

With that they were taught by PCSO ROBERTSON in a classroom environment and given a quiz with different types of parking to see whether they were good or bad parking.

They have now been set a task to create parking tickets that can be issued when they conduct their patrols , and once they have done that they will ask all parents who attend school to sign their parking promise, which will take place after Easter.
